entree	The act of entering. <i>She made a graceful entree into the ballroom.</i>
firewall	Protect a network or system from unauthorized access with a firewall. <i>He moved the throttle to the firewall.</i>
granary	A storehouse for threshed grain.
have	Have sex with. <i>Do you have a client named Peters.</i>

holding	Books, periodicals, magazines, and other material in a library. <i>Commercial property holdings.</i>
intentionally	Deliberately; on purpose. <i>I wasn't sure if it was intentionally funny or not.</i>
internal	Inside the body. <i>An internal sense of righteousness.</i>
maintain	Maintain by writing regular records. <i>He had persistently maintained that he would not stand against his old friend.</i>
memory	An electronic memory device. <i>A memory and the CPU form the central part of a computer to which peripherals are attached.</i>
parapsychology	Phenomena that appear to contradict physical laws and suggest the possibility of causation by mental processes.
preservation	The state of being preserved, especially to a specified degree. <i>Food preservation.</i>
preserve	A foodstuff made with fruit preserved in sugar such as jam or marmalade. <i>A fight to preserve local democracy.</i>
retention	Failure to eliminate a substance from the body. <i>The soil's retention of moisture.</i>
safe	Financially safe. <i>His world it's safe to say will not fall apart.</i>
security	Procedures followed or measures taken to ensure the security of a state or organization. <i>We support the armed services in the name of national security.</i>
semiconscious	Partially conscious; not completely aware of sensations.
storage	The retention of retrievable data on a computer or other electronic system. <i>Data storage.</i>
storehouse	A depository for goods. <i>An enormous storehouse of facts.</i>
sustainable	Able to be maintained at a certain rate or level. <i>Our fundamental commitment to sustainable development.</i>
uphold	Stand up for; stick up for; of causes, principles, or ideals. <i>They uphold a tradition of not causing distress to living creatures.</i>
