continuity	The unbroken and consistent existence or operation of something over time. A firm line of continuity between pre war and post war Britain.
continuous	Continuing in time or space without interruption- James Jeans. A continuous row of warehouses.
fusillade	Attack with fusillade. The Mahdi s adherents fusillade d his palace at Khartoum.
incessant	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. The incessant beat of the music.
maintain	Maintain for use and service. <i>He maintained his innocence.</i>
maintenance	Means of maintenance of a family or group. Essential maintenance work.



<u>nonstop</u>	(of a journey especially a flight) occurring without stops. <i>How many nonstops are there to Dallas.</i>
preservation	An occurrence of improvement by virtue of preventing loss or injury or other change. <i>The chapel is in a poor state of</i> preservation .
<u>preserve</u>	Fruit preserved by cooking with sugar. A jar of cherry preserve .
<u>recurrence</u>	The fact of occurring again. A drug used to prevent the recurrence of breast cancer.
<u>recurrent</u>	Occurring often or repeatedly. She had a recurrent dream about falling.
<u>retain</u>	Secure and keep for possible future use or application. <i>She retains a lawyer.</i>
<u>sequence</u>	Arrange in a sequence. They sequence d the human genome.
sequential	Performed or used in sequence. <i>Sequential</i> processing of data files.
seriatim	Taking one subject after another in regular order; point by point. It is proposed to deal with these matters seriatim .
<u>stabilize</u>	Become stable or more stable. <i>Stabilize</i> prices.
storehouse	A large supply of something. <i>Storehouse</i> s were built close to the docks.
<u>successive</u>	In regular succession without gaps. They were looking for their fifth successive win.
successively	Immediately one after another. <i>He served</i> successively as a major and a lieutenant colonel.
<u>sustainable</u>	Able to be upheld or defended. <i>Sustainable</i> economic growth.
unceasing	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The unceasing efforts of the staff.</i>
uninterrupted	Continuing in time or space without interruption- James Jeans. An uninterrupted flow of traffic.
uphold	Maintain (a custom or practice. They uphold a tradition of not causing distress to living creatures.
