fuss Elaborate or complex procedures; trouble or difficulty.

They settled in with very little **fuss**.

hoo-ha A disorderly outburst or tumult.hoo-hah A disorderly outburst or tumult.

hue and cry The quality of a color as determined by its dominant wavelength.

maelstrom A powerful circular current of water (usually the result of conflicting tides.

The train station was a **maelstrom** of crowds.

Melee A confused crowd of people.

Several people were hurt in the **melee**.

Flattery intended to persuade.

What a **palaver**.

racket. A snowshoe resembling a racket.

A squash **racket**.

The act of making a noisy disturbance.

There s enough **ruckus** over identity cards.

stir An act of stirring food or drink.

He gives his Ovaltine a **stir**.

Storm windows.

The manager is at the centre of a drugs **storm** in Germany.

to-do A disorderly outburst or tumult.

tumult A state of commotion and noise and confusion.

His personal **tumult** ended when he began writing songs.

A public expression of protest or outrage.

It caused an **uproar** in the press.
