According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "kerfuffle" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A disorderly outburst or tumult.
- A commotion or fuss, especially one caused by conflicting views.

Synonyms of "Kerfuffle" as a noun (21 Words)

brouhaha	Loud confused noise from many sources. <i>All that election brouhaha.</i>
clamour	A loud and confused noise, especially that of people shouting. <i>The questions rose to a clamour</i> .
<u>commotion</u>	A state of confused and noisy disturbance. Damage caused by civil commotion .
disruption	The act of causing disorder. <i>He gave hints on what industry today he believes may be ripe for disruption.</i>
<u>disturbance</u>	A disorderly outburst or tumult. They were amazed by the furious disturbance they had caused.



<u>flutter</u>	An act of fluttering. <i>Her insides were in a flutter.</i>
furore	An interest followed with exaggerated zeal. It was little thought that they would excite such a furore among stamp collectors.
<u>fuss</u>	Elaborate or complex procedures; trouble or difficulty. <i>They settled in with very little fuss.</i>
hoo-ha	A disorderly outburst or tumult.
hoo-hah	A disorderly outburst or tumult.
hue and cry	The quality of a color as determined by its dominant wavelength.
maelstrom	A powerful circular current of water (usually the result of conflicting tides <i>The train station was a maelstrom of crowds.</i>
melee	A confused crowd of people. Several people were hurt in the melee .
palaver	Flattery intended to persuade. What a palaver .
racket	A snowshoe resembling a racket. A squash racket .
<u>ruckus</u>	The act of making a noisy disturbance. There s enough ruckus over identity cards.
stir	An act of stirring food or drink. <i>He gives his Ovaltine a stir.</i>
<u>storm</u>	Storm windows. The manager is at the centre of a drugs storm in Germany.
to-do	A disorderly outburst or tumult.
tumult	A state of commotion and noise and confusion. His personal tumult ended when he began writing songs.
<u>uproar</u>	A public expression of protest or outrage. <i>It caused an uproar in the press.</i>
