I **am keynoting**

We **are keynoting**

## **Keynote in Present Perfect Tense**

I was keynoting                      We were keynoting  
You were keynoting                You were keynoting  
He/She/It was keynoting        They were keynoting

I had keynoted                      We had keynoted  
You had keynoted                You had keynoted  
He/She/It had keynoted        They had keynoted

He/She/It had been keynoting    They had been keynoting

He/She/It will keynote        They will keynote
