Infinitive	to keyseat
Present Tense	keyseat / keyseats
Past Tense	keyseated
Present Participle	keyseating
Past Participle	keyseated

# **Conjugate Keyseat**

#### **Keyseat in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>keyseat</b>	We <b>keyseat</b>
You <b>keyseat</b>	You <b>keyseat</b>
He/She/It keyseats	They <b>keyseat</b>

### **Keyseat in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am keyseating	We are keyseating
You are keyseating	You are keyseating
He/She/It is keyseating	They are keyseating

### **Keyseat in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have keyseated	We have keyseated
You have keyseated	You have keyseated
He/She/It has keyseated	They have keyseated

## **Keyseat in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been keyseating	We have been keyseating
You <b>have been keyseating</b>	You <b>have been keyseating</b>
He/She/It has been keyseating	They have been keyseating

## **Keyseat in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I keyseated	We <b>keyseated</b>
You <b>keyseated</b>	You <b>keyseated</b>
He/She/It <b>keyseated</b>	They <b>keyseated</b>

#### **Keyseat in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was keyseating	We were keyseating
You were keyseating	You were keyseating
He/She/It was keyseating	They were keyseating

### **Keyseat in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had keyseated	We had keyseated
You had keyseated	You had keyseated
He/She/It had keyseated	They had keyseated

### **Keyseat in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been keyseating	We had been keyseating
You <b>had been keyseating</b>	You had been keyseating
He/She/It had been keyseating	They had been keyseating

## **Keyseat in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will keyseat	We <b>will keyseat</b>
You <b>will keyseat</b>	You <b>will keyseat</b>
He/She/It will keyseat	They will keyseat

## **Keyseat in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be keyseating	We will be keyseating
You <b>will be keyseating</b>	You will be keyseating
He/She/It will be keyseating	They will be keyseating

### **Keyseat in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have keyseated	We will have keyseated
You <b>will have keyseated</b>	You will have keyseated
He/She/It will have keyseated	They will have keyseated

## **Keyseat in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been keyseating	We <b>will have been keyseating</b>
You <b>will have been keyseating</b>	You <b>will have been keyseating</b>
He/She/It will have been keyseating	They will have been keyseating
