Kidnap in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I kidnap We kidnap
You kidnap You kidnap
He/She/It kidnaps They kidnap

Kidnap in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am kidnapping or kidnaping
You are kidnapping or kidnaping
He/She/It is kidnapping or kidnaping
You are kidnapping or kidnaping
You are kidnapping or kidnaping

Kidnap in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have kidnapped or kidnaped
You have kidnapped or kidnaped
He/She/It has kidnapped or kidnaped
They have kidnapped or kidnaped

Kidnap in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been kidnapping or kidnaping
You have been kidnapping or kidnaping
He/She/It has been kidnapping or kidnaping
Heby have been kidnapping or kidnaping
They have been kidnapping or kidnaping

Kidnap in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I kidnapped or kidnaped
You kidnapped or kidnaped
He/She/It kidnapped or kidnaped
They kidnapped or kidnaped
They kidnapped or kidnaped



Kidnap in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Plural Singular

I was kidnapping or kidnaping We were kidnapping or kidnaping You were kidnapping or kidnaping You were kidnapping or kidnaping He/She/It was kidnapping or kidnaping They were kidnapping or kidnaping

Kidnap in Past Perfect Tense

Singular **Plural**

I had kidnapped or kidnaped We had kidnapped or kidnaped You had kidnapped or kidnaped You had kidnapped or kidnaped He/She/It had kidnapped or kidnaped They had kidnapped or kidnaped

Kidnap in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular **Plural**

I had been kidnapping or kidnaping We had been kidnapping or kidnaping You had been kidnapping or kidnaping You had been kidnapping or kidnaping He/She/It had been kidnapping or

kidnaping

They had been kidnapping or kidnaping

Kidnap in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural I will kidnap We will kidnap You will kidnap You will kidnap He/She/It will kidnap They will kidnap

Kidnap in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Plural Singular

I will be kidnapping or kidnaping We will be kidnapping or kidnaping You will be kidnapping or kidnaping You will be kidnapping or kidnaping He/She/It will be kidnapping or kidnaping They will be kidnapping or kidnaping



Kidnap in Future Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I will have kidnapped or kidnaped
You will have kidnapped or kidnaped
He/She/It will have kidnapped or kidnaped
