mushy Excessively sentimental.

Mushy effusiveness.

sappy Abounding in sap.

Sappy maple trees.

schmaltzy Excessively sentimental.
Schmaltzy ballads.

schmalzy Effusively or insincerely emotional.

sentimental Given to or marked by sentiment or sentimentality.

She felt a **sentimental** attachment to the place creep over her.

slushy Resembling, consisting of, or covered with slush.

Slushy snow.

Effusively or insincerely emotional.

An enjoyably **soppy** story.

soupy

Having the appearance or consistency of soup.

Soupy nostalgia.
