Infinitive	to knacker
Present Tense	knacker / knackers
Past Tense	knackered
Present Participle	knackering
Past Participle	knackered

# **Conjugate Knacker**

### **Knacker in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>knacker</b>	We <b>knacker</b>
You <b>knacker</b>	You <b>knacker</b>
He/She/It <b>knackers</b>	They <b>knacker</b>

## **Knacker in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am knackering	We <b>are knackering</b>
You <b>are knackering</b>	You <b>are knackering</b>
He/She/It is knackering	They are knackering

#### **Knacker in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have knackered	We have knackered
You have knackered	You have knackered
He/She/It has knackered	They have knackered

## **Knacker in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been knackering	We <b>have been knackering</b>
You <b>have been knackering</b>	You have been knackering
He/She/It has been knackering	They have been knackering

## **Knacker in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I knackered	We <b>knackered</b>
You <b>knackered</b>	You <b>knackered</b>
He/She/It <b>knackered</b>	They <b>knackered</b>

#### **Knacker in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was knackering	We were knackering
You <b>were knackering</b>	You were knackering
He/She/It was knackering	They were knackering

#### **Knacker in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had knackered	We had knackered
You had knackered	You had knackered
He/She/It had knackered	They had knackered

## **Knacker in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been knackering	We had been knackering
You <b>had been knackering</b>	You had been knackering
He/She/It had been knackering	They had been knackering

## **Knacker in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will knacker	We <b>will knacker</b>
You <b>will knacker</b>	You <b>will knacker</b>
He/She/It will knacker	They will knacker

## **Knacker in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be knackering	We <b>will be knackering</b>
You <b>will be knackering</b>	You will be knackering
He/She/It will be knackering	They will be knackering

### **Knacker in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have knackeredWe will have knackeredYou will have knackeredYou will have knackeredHe/She/It will have knackeredThey will have knackered

#### **Knacker in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been knackering	We <b>will have been knackering</b>
You <b>will have been knackering</b>	You <b>will have been knackering</b>
He/She/It will have been knackering	They will have been knackering
