Present Tense	know / knows
Past Tense	knewed
Present Participle	knowing
Past Participle	knewed

Conjugate Know

Know in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **know** We **know**
You **know** You **know**
He/She/It **knows** They **know**

Know in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am knowing** We **are knowing**
You **are knowing** You **are knowing**
He/She/It **is knowing** They **are knowing**

Know in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have knawed** We **have knawed**
You **have knawed** You **have knawed**
He/She/It **has knawed** They **have knawed**

Know in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been knowing** We **have been knowing**
You **have been knowing** You **have been knowing**
He/She/It **has been knowing** They **have been knowing**

Know in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **knawed** We **knawed**
You **knawed** You **knawed**
He/She/It **knawed** They **knawed**

Know in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was knowing

We were knowing

You were knowing

You were knowing

He/She/It was knowing **They were knowing**

Know in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had knawed

We had knawed

You had knawed

You had knawed

He/She/It had knawed **They had knawed**

Know in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been knowing

We had been knowing

You had been knowing

You had been knowing

He/She/It had been knowing **They had been knowing**

Know in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will know

We will know

You will know

You will know

He/She/It will know **They will know**

Know in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be knowing

We will be knowing

You will be knowing

You will be knowing

He/She/It will be knowing **They will be knowing**

Know in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have knawed

We will have knawed

You will have knawed

You will have knawed

He/She/It will have knawed

They will have knawed

I will have been knawing

We will have been knawing

You will have been knawing

You will have been knawing

He/She/It will have been knawing

They will have been knawing
