## Associations of "Know it all" (30 Words)

<b>acknowledge</b>	Recognize the importance or quality of. <i>The plight of the refugees was <b>acknowledged</b> by the authorities.</i>
<b><u>acquainted</u></b>	Having fair knowledge of. <i>Fully <b>acquainted</b> with the facts.</i>
<b>apprehensible</b>	Capable of being understood or perceived. <i>A bat whirred <b>apprehensible</b> only from the displacement of air.</i>
<b>approachable</b>	(of a place) able to be reached from a particular direction or by a particular means. <i>A site <b>approachable</b> from a branch of the Niger.</i>
<b>awareness</b>	Knowledge or perception of a situation or fact. <i>We need to raise public <b>awareness</b> of the issue.</i>
<b>cognitive</b>	Relating to cognition. <i>The <b>cognitive</b> processes involved in reading.</i>
<b>comprehend</b>	To become aware of through the senses. <i>He couldn't <b>comprehend</b> her reasons for marrying Lovat.</i>
<b>comprehensible</b>	Capable of being comprehended or understood. <i>Clear and <b>comprehensible</b> English.</i>
<b>consciously</b>	In a way that is directly perceptible to and under the control of the person concerned. <i>A vicious and <b>consciously</b> dishonest hatchet job.</i>
<b><u>consciousness</u></b>	An alert cognitive state in which you are aware of yourself and your situation. <i>His sudden <b>consciousness</b> of the problem he faced.</i>
<b><u>conversant</u></b>	Familiar with or knowledgeable about something. <i>You need someone who is <b>conversant</b> with the new technology.</i>
<b>enlightened</b>	People who have been introduced to the mysteries of some field or activity. <i>We become <b>enlightened</b> in our relationship with God.</i>

<b>enlightenment</b>	(Hinduism and Buddhism) the beatitude that transcends the cycle of reincarnation; characterized by the extinction of desire and suffering and individual consciousness. <i>Robbie looked to me for <b>enlightenment</b>.</i>
<b>familiar</b>	Often encountered or experienced; common. <i>A <b>familiar</b> everyday scene.</i>
<b>familiarly</b>	In an intimately familiar manner.
<b>informed</b>	Having much knowledge or education. <i>An <b>informed</b> readership.</i>
<b>intelligible</b>	Well articulated or enunciated, and loud enough to be heard distinctly. <i>A barely <b>intelligible</b> reply.</i>
<b>intuitively</b>	Without conscious reasoning; instinctively. <i>They <b>intuitively</b> understood each other.</i>
<b>knowledge</b>	Information held on a computer system. <i>Her considerable <b>knowledge</b> of antiques.</i>
<b>perceivable</b>	Capable of being apprehended or understood. <i><b>Perceivable</b> through the mist.</i>
<b>perception</b>	The way in which something is regarded, understood, or interpreted. <i>He wouldn't have accepted said my mother with unusual <b>perception</b>.</i>
<b>predictable</b>	Able to be predicted. <i>The characters are stereotyped and extremely <b>predictable</b>.</i>
<b>realize</b>	Make (a profit) from a transaction. <i>The stage designs have been beautifully <b>realized</b>.</i>
<b>recognition</b>	Appreciation or acclaim for an achievement, service, or ability. <i>A sudden <b>recognition</b> of the problem he faced.</i>
<b>recognize</b>	Express greetings upon meeting someone. <i>We do not <b>recognize</b> your gods.</i>
<b>sensate</b>	Perceiving or perceived by the senses. <i><b>Sensate</b> creatures.</i>
<b>sentient</b>	Consciously perceiving- W.A.White. <i>The living knew themselves just <b>sentient</b> puppets on God's stage.</i>
<b>understand</b>	Be understanding of. <i>I <b>understand</b> you're at art school.</i>
<b>understandable</b>	To be expected; natural, reasonable, or forgivable. <i>It is <b>understandable</b> that mistakes occur sometimes.</i>

**understanding** Characterized by understanding based on comprehension and discernment and empathy.  
*He and I have an **understanding**.*
