acknowledge	Recognize the importance or quality of. <i>The plight of the refugees was acknowledged by the authorities.</i>
<u>acquainted</u>	Having fair knowledge of. Fully acquainted with the facts.
apprehensible	Capable of being understood or perceived. A bat whirred apprehensible only from the displacement of air.
approachable	(of a place) able to be reached from a particular direction or by a particular means. A site approachable from a branch of the Niger.
awareness	Knowledge or perception of a situation or fact. We need to raise public awareness of the issue.
cognitive	Relating to cognition. The cognitive processes involved in reading.
comprehend	To become aware of through the senses. <i>He couldn t comprehend her reasons for marrying Lovat.</i>
comprehensible	Capable of being comprehended or understood. Clear and comprehensible English.
consciously	In a way that is directly perceptible to and under the control of the person concerned. A vicious and consciously dishonest hatchet job.
<u>consciousness</u>	An alert cognitive state in which you are aware of yourself and your situation. His sudden consciousness of the problem he faced.
<u>conversant</u>	Familiar with or knowledgeable about something. You need someone who is conversant with the new technology.
enlightened	People who have been introduced to the mysteries of some field or activity. We become enlightened in our relationship with God.



enlightenment	(Hinduism and Buddhism) the beatitude that transcends the cycle of reincarnation; characterized by the extinction of desire and suffering and individual consciousness. <i>Robbie looked to me for enlightenment</i> .
<u>familiar</u>	Often encountered or experienced; common. A familiar everyday scene.
familiarly	In an intimately familiar manner.
informed	Having much knowledge or education. An informed readership.
intelligible	Well articulated or enunciated, and loud enough to be heard distinctly. <i>A barely intelligible reply</i> .
intuitively	Without conscious reasoning; instinctively. They intuitively understood each other.
knowledge	Information held on a computer system. Her considerable knowledge of antiques.
perceivable	Capable of being apprehended or understood. <i>Perceivable</i> through the mist.
perception	The way in which something is regarded, understood, or interpreted. <i>He wouldn t have accepted said my mother with unusual perception.</i>
<u>predictable</u>	Able to be predicted. The characters are stereotyped and extremely predictable .
realize	Make (a profit) from a transaction. The stage designs have been beautifully realize d.
recognition	Appreciation or acclaim for an achievement, service, or ability. A sudden recognition of the problem he faced.
recognize	Express greetings upon meeting someone. We do not recognize your gods.
sensate	Perceiving or perceived by the senses. Sensate creatures.
<u>sentient</u>	Consciously perceiving- W.A.White. The living knew themselves just sentient puppets on God s stage.
understand	Be understanding of. I understand you re at art school.
understandable	To be expected; natural, reasonable, or forgivable. It is understandable that mistakes occur sometimes.



understanding Characterized by understanding based on comprehension and discernment and empathy. *He and I have an understanding.*
