Infinitive	to know
Present Tense	know / knows
Past Tense	knew or knowed (dialect),
Present Participle	knowing
Past Participle	known, knowen (archaic), or knowed (dialect)

Conjugate Know

Know in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **know** We **know**
You **know** You **know**
He/She/It **knows** They **know**

Know in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am knowing** We **are knowing**
You **are knowing** You **are knowing**
He/She/It **is knowing** They **are knowing**

Know in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I have known, known (archaic), or knowed (dialect)	We have known, known (archaic), or knowed (dialect)
You have known, known (archaic), or knowed (dialect)	You have known, known (archaic), or knowed (dialect)
He/She/It has known, known (archaic), or knowed (dialect)	They have known, known (archaic), or knowed (dialect)

Know in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been knowing** We **have been knowing**
You **have been knowing** You **have been knowing**
He/She/It **has been knowing** They **have been knowing**

Know in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **knew or knowed (dialect),** We **knew or knowed (dialect),**
You **knew or knowed (dialect),** You **knew or knowed (dialect),**
He/She/It **knew or knowed (dialect),** They **knew or knowed (dialect),**

Know in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I was knowing

You were knowing

He/She/It was knowing

Plural

We were knowing

You were knowing

They were knowing

Know in Past Perfect Tense

**I had known, known (archaic), or

**You had known, known (archaic), or
knewed (dialect)**

**He/She/It had known, known (archaic),
or knewed (dialect)**

Plural

**We had known, known (archaic), or

Know in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

I had been knowing

You had been knowing

He/She/It had been knowing

Plural

We had been knowing

You had been knowing

They had been knowing

Know in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will know

You will know

He/She/It will know

Plural

We will know

You will know

They will know

Know in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I will be knowing

You will be knowing

Plural

We will be knowing

You will be knowing

He/She/It **will be knowing** They **will be knowing**
