Present Tense	label / labels
Past Tense	labelled (uk, some us) or labeled (us)
Present Participle	labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)
Past Participle	labelled (uk, some us) or labeled (us)

Label in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

He/She/It labels	They label

Label in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)	We are labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)
You are labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)	You are labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)
He/She/It is labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)	They are labelling (uk, some us) or labeling (us)

Label in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
