# **The Forms of Lament**

Infinitive	to lament
Present Tense	lament / laments
Past Tense	lamented
Present Participle	lamenting
Past Participle	lamented

# **Conjugate Lament**

## Lament in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I lament	We <b>lament</b>
You <b>lament</b>	You <b>lament</b>
He/She/It <b>laments</b>	They lament

# Lament in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am lamenting	We <b>are lamenting</b>
You <b>are lamenting</b>	You <b>are lamenting</b>
He/She/It is lamenting	They are lamenting

## **Lament in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have lamented	We have lamented
You have lamented	You have lamented
He/She/It has lamented	They have lamented

## Lament in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been lamenting	We have been lamenting
You <b>have been lamenting</b>	You have been lamenting
He/She/It has been lamenting	They have been lamenting

# Lament in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I lamented	We <b>lamented</b>
You <b>lamented</b>	You lamented
He/She/It lamented	They lamented

# Lament in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



SingularPluralI was lamentingWe were lamentingYou were lamentingYou were lamentingHe/She/It was lamentingThey were lamenting

## **Lament in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had lamented	We had lamented
You had lamented	You had lamented
He/She/It had lamented	They had lamented

## Lament in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been lamenting	We had been lamenting
You <b>had been lamenting</b>	You had been lamenting
He/She/It had been lamenting	They had been lamenting

# Lament in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will lament	We will lament
You <b>will lament</b>	You <b>will lament</b>
He/She/It will lament	They will lament

## Lament in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be lamenting	We will be lamenting
You <b>will be lamenting</b>	You will be lamenting
He/She/It will be lamenting	They will be lamenting

## **Lament in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have lamentedWe will have lamentedYou will have lamentedYou will have lamentedHe/She/It will have lamentedThey will have lamented

## Lament in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been lamenting	We <b>will have been lamenting</b>
You <b>will have been lamenting</b>	You will have been lamenting
He/She/It will have been lamenting	They will have been lamenting
