Landmark in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I landmark
You landmark
He/She/It landmarks
They landmark

Landmark in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am landmarking We are landmarking
You are landmarking You are landmarking
He/She/It is landmarking They are landmarking

Landmark in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have landmarked We have landmarked You have landmarked You have landmarked He/She/It has landmarked They have landmarked

Landmark in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been landmarking We have been landmarking
You have been landmarking You have been landmarking
He/She/It has been landmarking They have been landmarking

Landmark in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **landmarked** We **landmarked**You **landmarked** You **landmarked**He/She/It **landmarked** They **landmarked**

Landmark in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was landmarking We were landmarking
You were landmarking You were landmarking
He/She/It was landmarking They were landmarking

Landmark in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had landmarked We had landmarked
You had landmarked You had landmarked
He/She/It had landmarked They had landmarked

Landmark in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been landmarking We had been landmarking
You had been landmarking You had been landmarking
He/She/It had been landmarking They had been landmarking

Landmark in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will landmark
You will landmark
He/She/It will landmark
They will landmark

Landmark in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be landmarking We will be landmarking
You will be landmarking You will be landmarking
He/She/It will be landmarking They will be landmarking

Landmark in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have landmarked
You will have landmarked
He/She/It will have landmarked
They will have landmarked

You will have been landmarking
