He/She/It **languages** They **language**

## **Language in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am languaging**

We **are languaging**

You **are languaging**

You **are languaging**

He/She/It **is languaging** They **are languaging**

## **Language in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have languaged**

We **have languaged**

You **have languaged**

You **have languaged**

He/She/It **has languaged** They **have languaged**

## **Language in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been languaging**

We **have been languaging**

You **have been languaging**

You **have been languaging**

He/She/It **has been languaging** They **have been languaging**

## **Language in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **languaged**

We **languaged**

You **languaged**

You **languaged**

He/She/It **languaged** They **languaged**

## **Language in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I was languaging                      We were languaging  
You were languaging                You were languaging  
He/She/It was languaging        They were languaging

**Language in Past Perfect Tense**

I had languaged                      We had languaged  
You had languaged                You had languaged  
He/She/It had languaged        They had languaged

**Language in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I had been languaging              We had been languaging  
You had been languaging            You had been languaging  
He/She/It had been languaging    They had been languaging

**Language in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will language                      We will language  
You will language                You will language  
He/She/It will language        They will language

**Language in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be languaging                We will be languaging  
You will be languaging            You will be languaging  
He/She/It will be languaging    They will be languaging

**I will have languaged**

**We will have languaged**

**You will have languaged**

**He/She/It will have languaged**

**They will have languaged**
