asterisk	Mark with an asterisk. <i>He had asterisked the things about the case that still bothered him.</i>
connotation	The abstract meaning or intension of a term, which forms a principle determining which objects or concepts it applies to. <i>The word discipline has unhappy connotations of punishment and repression.</i>
context	The circumstances that form the setting for an event, statement, or idea, and in terms of which it can be fully understood. <i>The proposals need to be considered in the context of new European directives.</i>
cryptic	Having a secret or hidden meaning- John Gunther. <i>Cryptic writings.</i>
dah	The longer of the two telegraphic signals used in Morse code. Read with difficulty.
decipher	<i>Authorized government agencies can decipher encrypted telecommunications.</i>
denotation	The most direct or specific meaning of a word or expression; the class of objects that an expression refers to. <i>Beyond their immediate denotation the words have a connotative power.</i>
egyptian	Of or relating to or characteristic of Egypt or its people or their language.
equivocally	In an ambiguous manner.
exclude	Prevent from entering; shut out. <i>The cost for the trip excludes food and beverages.</i>
exhale	Breathe out. <i>The chimney exhales a thick smoke.</i>
extrinsic	Not forming an essential part of a thing or arising or originating from the outside. <i>That style is something extrinsic to the subject.</i>

figurative	Consisting of or forming human or animal figures. <i>The figurative art of the humanistic tradition.</i>
glyph	A hieroglyphic character or symbol. <i>Flanges painted with esoteric glyphs.</i>
hieroglyph	Writing that resembles hieroglyphics usually by being illegible. <i>The International Organisation for Standardization is introducing two new hieroglyphs to perplex washing machine owners.</i>
home	At or to or in the direction of one's home or family. <i>The floods forced many people to flee their homes.</i>
import	The action or process of importing goods or services. <i>Cheap imports from eastern Europe.</i>
indication	A reason to prescribe a drug or perform a procedure. <i>There were indications that it was time to leave.</i>
interpret	Give an interpretation or rendition of. <i>Interpreting the music well takes hours of listening and experimentation.</i>
literally	Used for emphasis while not being literally true. <i>The driver took it literally when asked to go straight over the roundabout.</i>
mark	Make small marks into the surface of. <i>Mark homework.</i>
metaphorical	Characteristic of or relating to metaphor; figurative. <i>Many of our metaphorical expressions develop from our perceptions of the body.</i>
oracular	Of or relating to an oracle. <i>An oracular message.</i>
outside	The region that is outside of something. <i>The outside world.</i>
parenthesis	A message that departs from the main subject. <i>The three months of coalition government were a lamentable political parenthesis.</i>
semantic	Relating to meaning in language or logic.
significance	The message that is intended or expressed or signified. <i>The significance of a red traffic light.</i>
term	Name formally or designate with a term. <i>The United States played a key role in prodding the two sides to come to terms.</i>
text	A textbook. <i>He took as his text the fact that Australia is paradise.</i>
