adieu	A goodbye. He whispered a fond <b>adieu</b> .
after	At a later or future time afterwards. <i>He was sorry in <b>after</b> years.</i>
afterthought	Thinking again about a choice previously made. The garage was an <b>afterthought</b> .
aloha	An utterance of aloha. The <b>aloha</b> spirit.
<u>back</u>	The part of a garment that covers a person s back. Things were <b>back</b> to normal.
backward	In or to or toward a past time. <b>Backward</b> square leg.
backwards	In reverse of the usual direction or order. The songs look <b>backwards</b> to long ago battles.
behind	A kick that sends the ball over a behind line or a touch that sends it between the inner posts scoring one point. Ben led the way with Joe a short distance <b>behind</b> .
bye	A run scored from a ball that passes the batsman without being hit (recorded as an extra, not credited to the individual batsman). <i>He has a <b>bye</b> into the second round.</i>
<u>concomitant</u>	Following or accompanying as a consequence. She loved travel with all its <b>concomitant</b> worries.
defer	Yield to another's wish or opinion. The judge <b>defer</b> red sentence until 5 April for background reports.



degeneracy	Moral perversion; impairment of virtue and moral principles. A slide into moral <b>degeneracy</b> .
dorsal	Belonging to or on or near the back or upper surface of an animal or organ or part. <i>A <b>dorsal</b> view of the body.</i>
following	Immediately following in time or order. A <b>following</b> wind.
goodbye	An instance of saying goodbye a parting. We said our <b>goodbye</b> s and set off.
<u>lag</u>	Cover with lagging to prevent heat loss. They waited for Tim who was <b>lag</b> ging behind.
<u>late</u>	At or toward an end or late period or stage of development. <i>Had a late breakfast.</i>
latency	The delay before a transfer of data begins following an instruction for its transfer. The disease s <b>latency</b> period can last up to five years.
medial	(of a speech sound) in the middle of a word. A <b>medial</b> consonant.
posterior	Relating to or denoting presentation of a fetus in which the rear or caudal end is nearest the cervix and emerges first at birth. <i>A basal body situated just <b>posterior</b> to the nucleus.</i>
posthumous	Occurring or coming into existence after a person's death. A <b>posthumous</b> book.
rear	Located in or toward the back or rear. The kitchen door at the <b>rear</b> of the house.
retraction	A disavowal or taking back of a previous assertion. <i>Retraction</i> of the foreskin.
retreat	Make a retreat from an earlier commitment or activity. The Pope <b>retreat</b> s to Castelgondolfo every summer.
retrospective	(of an exhibition or compilation) showing the development of an artist's work over a period of time. A <b>retrospective</b> collection of albums spanning the course of his entire career.
<u>subsequent</u>	Coming after something in time; following. <i>Subsequent</i> developments.
subsequently	Happening at a time subsequent to a reference time. The officer decided to stop and <b>subsequently</b> made an arrest.
