accompanying	Following or accompanying as a consequence. <i>Owning a home brings with it a horde of accompanying expenses.</i>
adieu	A goodbye. <i>He whispered a fond adieu.</i>
after	At a later or future time afterwards. <i>He was sorry in after years.</i>
afterthought	Thinking again about a choice previously made. <i>The garage was an afterthought.</i>
aloha	An utterance of aloha. <i>The aloha spirit.</i>
back	The part of a garment that covers a person s back. <i>Things were back to normal.</i>
backward	In or to or toward a past time. <i>Backward square leg.</i>
backwards	In reverse of the usual direction or order. <i>The songs look backwards to long ago battles.</i>
behind	A kick that sends the ball over a behind line or a touch that sends it between the inner posts scoring one point. <i>Ben led the way with Joe a short distance behind.</i>
bye	A run scored from a ball that passes the batsman without being hit (recorded as an extra, not credited to the individual batsman). <i>He has a bye into the second round.</i>
concomitant	Following or accompanying as a consequence. <i>She loved travel with all its concomitant worries.</i>
defer	Yield to another’s wish or opinion. <i>The judge deferred sentence until 5 April for background reports.</i>

degeneracy	Moral perversion; impairment of virtue and moral principles. <i>A slide into moral degeneracy.</i>
dorsal	Belonging to or on or near the back or upper surface of an animal or organ or part. <i>A dorsal view of the body.</i>
following	Immediately following in time or order. <i>A following wind.</i>
goodbye	An instance of saying goodbye a parting. <i>We said our goodbyes and set off.</i>
lag	Cover with lagging to prevent heat loss. <i>They waited for Tim who was lagging behind.</i>
late	At or toward an end or late period or stage of development. <i>Had a late breakfast.</i>
latency	The delay before a transfer of data begins following an instruction for its transfer. <i>The disease s latency period can last up to five years.</i>
medial	(of a speech sound) in the middle of a word. <i>A medial consonant.</i>
posterior	Relating to or denoting presentation of a fetus in which the rear or caudal end is nearest the cervix and emerges first at birth. <i>A basal body situated just posterior to the nucleus.</i>
posthumous	Occurring or coming into existence after a person's death. <i>A posthumous book.</i>
rear	Located in or toward the back or rear. <i>The kitchen door at the rear of the house.</i>
retraction	A disavowal or taking back of a previous assertion. <i>Retraction of the foreskin.</i>
retreat	Make a retreat from an earlier commitment or activity. <i>The Pope retreats to Castelgondolfo every summer.</i>
retrospective	(of an exhibition or compilation) showing the development of an artist's work over a period of time. <i>A retrospective collection of albums spanning the course of his entire career.</i>
subsequent	Coming after something in time; following. <i>Subsequent developments.</i>
subsequently	Happening at a time subsequent to a reference time. <i>The officer decided to stop and subsequently made an arrest.</i>
