Lateral in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I lateral We lateral
You lateral You lateral
He/She/It laterals They lateral

Lateral in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am lateralling or lateraling
You are lateralling or lateraling
He/She/It is lateralling or lateraling
They are lateralling or lateraling

Lateral in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have lateralled or lateraled
You have lateralled or lateraled
You have lateralled or lateraled
He/She/It has lateralled or lateraled
They have lateralled or lateraled

Lateral in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I have been lateralling or lateraling
You have been lateralling or lateraling

You will lateral You will lateral
