- *The way in which text or pictures are set out on a page.*



## Synonyms of "Layout" as a noun (18 Words)

<b>arrangement</b>	A musical composition arranged for performance with instruments or voices differing from those originally specified. <i>The travel agents have an <b>arrangement</b> with the hotel.</i>
<b>construction</b>	The arrangement of words according to syntactical rules. <i>Their main business is home <b>construction</b>.</i>
<b>design</b>	Purpose or planning that exists behind an action, fact, or object. <i>He made no secret of his <b>designs</b>.</i>
<b><u>format</u></b>	The organization of information according to preset specifications usually for computer processing. <i>The conventional <b>format</b> of TV situation comedies.</i>
<b>framework</b>	A hypothetical description of a complex entity or process. <i>Providing a factual <b>framework</b> for future research.</i>

<a href="#"><u>geography</u></a>	Study of the earth's surface; includes people's responses to topography and climate and soil and vegetation. <i>The <b>geography</b> of post war London.</i>
<b>make-up</b>	An event that is substituted for a previously cancelled event.
<b>order</b>	An institution founded by a monarch along the lines of a medieval crusading monastic order for the purpose of honouring meritorious conduct. <i>They were dedicated to overthrowing the established <b>order</b>.</i>
<b>orderliness</b>	A condition of regular or proper arrangement.
<b>organization</b>	The act of organizing a business or an activity related to a business. <i>The <b>organization</b> of conferences.</i>
<b>planning</b>	The act or process of drawing up plans or layouts for some project or enterprise. <i><b>Planning</b> applications.</i>
<b>presentation</b>	A visual representation of something. <i>All patients in this group were symptomatic at initial <b>presentation</b>.</i>
<b>proportion</b>	Harmonious arrangement or relation of parts or elements within a whole (as in a design)- John Ruskin. <i>A building of vast <b>proportions</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>shape</u></a>	The state of good health especially in the phrases in condition or in shape or out of condition or out of shape. <i>She liked the <b>shape</b> of his nose.</i>
<b>structure</b>	The people in a society considered as a system organized by a characteristic pattern of relationships. <i>The station is a magnificent <b>structure</b> and should not be demolished.</i>
<b>style</b>	In an invertebrate a small slender pointed appendage a stylet. <i>Different <b>styles</b> of management.</i>
<a href="#"><u>symmetry</u></a>	(physics) the property of being isotropic; having the same value when measured in different directions. <i>This series has a line of <b>symmetry</b> through its centre.</i>
<b>system</b>	A set of staves in a musical score joined by a brace. <i>In a static <b>system</b> oil cannot be replaced by water on a surface.</i>

## Associations of "Layout" (30 Words)

<b>additional</b>	Added, extra, or supplementary to what is already present or available. <i>Called for <b>additional</b> troops.</i>
<u><a href="#">array</a></u>	An arrangement of troops. <i>He was clothed in fine <b>array</b>.</i>

<b>cloy</b>	Disgust or sicken (someone) with an excess of sweetness, richness, or sentiment. <i>Too much spicy food <b>cloyed</b> his appetite.</i>
<b><u>configuration</u></b>	An arrangement of parts or elements in a particular form, figure, or combination. <i>The broad <b>configuration</b> of the economy remains capitalist.</i>
<b>dimensional</b>	Having dimension-the quality or character or stature proper to a person. <i>Well rounded fully <b>dimensional</b> characters.</i>
<b>discharge</b>	Go off or discharge. <i>The eyes and nose began to <b>discharge</b>.</i>
<b>dispensable</b>	Able to be replaced or done without; superfluous. <i>The captain's loss of form made him <b>dispensable</b>.</i>
<b>display</b>	Attract attention by displaying some body part or posing of animals. <i>Every clansman was determined to outdo the Campbells in <b>display</b>.</i>
<b><u>excess</u></b>	Excessive indulgence. <i>Trying to lose <b>excess</b> weight.</i>
<b>exhibit</b>	An exhibition. <i>He <b>exhibits</b> a great talent.</i>
<b>extra</b>	Excessive or extravagant. <i>An <b>extra</b> pair of shoes.</i>
<b>extraneous</b>	Coming from the outside. <i>When the transmitter pack is turned off no <b>extraneous</b> noise is heard.</i>
<b><u>gallery</u></b>	A balcony or upper floor projecting from an interior back or side wall of a hall or church, providing space for an audience or musicians. <i>An art <b>gallery</b>.</i>
<b>glut</b>	Overeat or eat immodestly; make a pig of oneself. <i>He planned a treacherous murder to <b>glut</b> his desire for revenge.</i>
<b>grid</b>	A grid of regular squares on a map that are marked with numbers or letters to enable a place to be precisely located. <i>The fen is <b>gridded</b> by intersecting dykes.</i>
<b>needless</b>	(of something undesirable) not necessary because avoidable. <i>I deplore <b>needless</b> waste.</i>
<b>oversupply</b>	An excessive supply. <i><b>Oversupply</b> causes prices to fall.</i>
<b>permissive</b>	Denoting a path available for public use by the landowner's consent, not as a legal right of way. <i><b>Permissive</b> parents.</i>

<b><u>planned</u></b>	Planned in advance. <i>The <b>planned</b> outlays for new equipment.</i>
<b><u>plethora</u></b>	An excess of a bodily fluid, particularly blood. <i>Allen won a <b>plethora</b> of medals during his illustrious career.</i>
<b>redundance</b>	The attribute of being superfluous and unneeded.
<b>redundancy</b>	The state of being no longer in employment because there is no more work available. <i>The use of industrial robots created <b>redundancy</b> among workers.</i>
<b>redundant</b>	(of words or data) able to be omitted without loss of meaning or function. <i>The modules are linked using a <b>redundant</b> fibre optic cable.</i>
<b>supererogatory</b>	More than is needed, desired, or required. <i>It was <b>supererogatory</b> of her to gloat.</i>
<b>superfluity</b>	An unnecessarily or excessively large amount or number of something. <i>They thought the garrison a <b>superfluity</b>.</i>
<b>superfluous</b>	More than is needed, desired, or required. <i>The purchaser should avoid asking for <b>superfluous</b> information.</i>
<b>supernumerary</b>	A supernumerary person or thing. <i>Books were obviously <b>supernumerary</b> and he began jettisoning them.</i>
<b>surfeit</b>	Supply or feed to surfeit. <i>A <b>surfeit</b> of food and drink.</i>
<b><u>surplus</u></b>	An amount of something left over when requirements have been met; an excess of production or supply. <i>The firm told 284 employees that they were <b>surplus</b> to requirements.</i>
<b>unnecessary</b>	Unnecessary things. <i>Some people feel that holiday insurance is <b>unnecessary</b>.</i>
