## The Forms of Lean

Infinitive	<b>to lean</b>
Present Tense	<b>lean / leans</b>
Past Tense	<b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>
Present Participle	<b>leaning</b>
Past Participle	<b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>

## Conjugate Lean

**Lean in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>lean</b>	We <b>lean</b>
You <b>lean</b>	You <b>lean</b>
He/She/It <b>leans</b>	They <b>lean</b>

### **Lean in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am leaning</b>	We <b>are leaning</b>
You <b>are leaning</b>	You <b>are leaning</b>
He/She/It <b>is leaning</b>	They <b>are leaning</b>

### **Lean in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have leaned or leant (especially british)</b>	We <b>have leaned or leant (especially british)</b>
You <b>have leaned or leant (especially british)</b>	You <b>have leaned or leant (especially british)</b>
He/She/It <b>has leaned or leant (especially british)</b>	They <b>have leaned or leant (especially british)</b>

### **Lean in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been leaning</b>	We <b>have been leaning</b>
You <b>have been leaning</b>	You <b>have been leaning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been leaning</b>	They <b>have been leaning</b>

### **Lean in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>	We <b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>
You <b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>	You <b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>
He/She/It <b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>	They <b>leaned or leant (especially british)</b>

## **Lean in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I was leaning**

**You were leaning**

**He/She/It was leaning**

### **Plural**

**We were leaning**

**You were leaning**

**They were leaning**

## **Lean in Past Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

**I had leaned or leant (especially british)**

**You had leaned or leant (especially british)**

**He/She/It had leaned or leant (especially british)**

### **Plural**

**We had leaned or leant (especially british)**

**You had leaned or leant (especially british)**

**They had leaned or leant (especially british)**

## **Lean in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Singular**

**I had been leaning**

**You had been leaning**

**He/She/It had been leaning**

### **Plural**

**We had been leaning**

**You had been leaning**

**They had been leaning**

## **Lean in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will lean**

**You will lean**

**He/She/It will lean**

### **Plural**

**We will lean**

**You will lean**

**They will lean**

## **Lean in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will be leaning**

**You will be leaning**

### **Plural**

**We will be leaning**

**You will be leaning**

**Singular**

**Plural**

He/She/It **will be leaning** They **will be leaning**

**Lean in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will have leaned or leant (especially british)**

We **will have leaned or leant (especially british)**

You **will have leaned or leant (especially british)**

You **will have leaned or leant (especially british)**

He/She/It **will have leaned or leant (especially british)**

They **will have leaned or leant (especially british)**

**Lean in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will have been leaning**

We **will have been leaning**

You **will have been leaning**

You **will have been leaning**

He/She/It **will have been leaning** They **will have been leaning**
