## The Forms of Leap

Infinitive	<b>to leap</b>
Present Tense	<b>leap / leaps</b>
Past Tense	<b>leaped, leapt, or archaically left or lope</b>
Present Participle	<b>leaping</b>
Past Participle	<b>leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>

## Conjugate Leap

### Leap in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I leap</b>	<b>We leap</b>
<b>You leap</b>	<b>You leap</b>
<b>He/She/It leaps</b>	<b>They leap</b>

### **Leap in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I am leaping</b>	<b>We are leaping</b>
<b>You are leaping</b>	<b>You are leaping</b>
<b>He/She/It is leaping</b>	<b>They are leaping</b>

### **Leap in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>	<b>We have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>
<b>You have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>	<b>You have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>
<b>He/She/It has leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>	<b>They have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen</b>

### **Leap in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I have been leaping</b>	<b>We have been leaping</b>
<b>You have been leaping</b>	<b>You have been leaping</b>
<b>He/She/It has been leaping</b>	<b>They have been leaping</b>

### **Leap in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I leaped, leapt, or archaically leapt or lope</b>	<b>We leaped, leapt, or archaically leapt or lope</b>
<b>You leaped, leapt, or archaically leapt or lope</b>	<b>You leaped, leapt, or archaically leapt or lope</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

He/She/It **leaped, leapt, or archaically lept or lope**      They **leaped, leapt, or archaically lept or lope**

**Leap in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was leaping**      We **were leaping**  
You **were leaping**      You **were leaping**  
He/She/It **was leaping**      They **were leaping**

**Leap in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**      We **had leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**  
You **had leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**      You **had leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**  
He/She/It **had leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**      They **had leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

**Leap in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been leaping**      We **had been leaping**  
You **had been leaping**      You **had been leaping**  
He/She/It **had been leaping**      They **had been leaping**

**Leap in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will leap**      We **will leap**  
You **will leap**      You **will leap**  
He/She/It **will leap**      They **will leap**

## **Leap in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will be leaping**

**You will be leaping**

**He/She/It will be leaping**

### **Plural**

**We will be leaping**

**You will be leaping**

**They will be leaping**

## **Leap in Future Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

**You will have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

**He/She/It will have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

### **Plural**

**We will have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

**You will have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

**They will have leaped, leapt, or archaically lopen**

## **Leap in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will have been leaping**

**You will have been leaping**

**He/She/It will have been leaping**

### **Plural**

**We will have been leaping**

**You will have been leaping**

**They will have been leaping**
