Infinitive	<b>to lear</b>
Present Tense	<b>lear / lears</b>
Past Tense	<b>leared</b>
Present Participle	<b>learing</b>
Past Participle	<b>leared</b>

## Conjugate Lear

**Lear in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>lear</b>	We <b>lear</b>
You <b>lear</b>	You <b>lear</b>
He/She/It <b>lears</b>	They <b>lear</b>

### **Lear in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am learing</b>	We <b>are learing</b>
You <b>are learing</b>	You <b>are learing</b>
He/She/It <b>is learing</b>	They <b>are learing</b>

### **Lear in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have leared</b>	We <b>have leared</b>
You <b>have leared</b>	You <b>have leared</b>
He/She/It <b>has leared</b>	They <b>have leared</b>

### **Lear in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been learing</b>	We <b>have been learing</b>
You <b>have been learing</b>	You <b>have been learing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been learing</b>	They <b>have been learing</b>

### **Lear in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>leared</b>	We <b>leared</b>
You <b>leared</b>	You <b>leared</b>
He/She/It <b>leared</b>	They <b>leared</b>

### **Lear in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was learing                      We were learing  
You were learing                You were learing  
He/She/It was learing        They were learing

**Lear in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had leared                      We had leared  
You had leared                You had leared  
He/She/It had leared        They had leared

**Lear in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been learing                We had been learing  
You had been learing            You had been learing  
He/She/It had been learing    They had been learing

**Lear in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will lear                      We will lear  
You will lear                You will lear  
He/She/It will lear        They will lear

**Lear in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be learing                We will be learing  
You will be learing            You will be learing  
He/She/It will be learing    They will be learing

**Lear in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have leared**

**We will have leared**

**You will have leared**

**You will have leared**

**He/She/It will have leared**

**They will have leared**

**Lear in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been learing**

**We will have been learing**

**You will have been learing**

**You will have been learing**

**He/She/It will have been learing**

**They will have been learing**
