# **Conjugate Leash**

## Leash in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>leash</b>	We <b>leash</b>
You <b>leash</b>	You <b>leash</b>
He/She/It <b>leashes</b>	They <b>leash</b>

## Leash in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am leashing	We <b>are leashing</b>
You <b>are leashing</b>	You <b>are leashing</b>
He/She/It is leashing	They are leashing

#### **Leash in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have leashed	We have leashed
You have leashed	You have leashed
He/She/It has leashed	They have leashed

## Leash in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been leashing	We have been leashing
You <b>have been leashing</b>	You have been leashing
He/She/It has been leashing	They have been leashing

## Leash in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I leashed	We <b>leashed</b>
You <b>leashed</b>	You <b>leashed</b>
He/She/It leashed	They <b>leashed</b>

## Leash in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was leashing	We <b>were leashing</b>
You <b>were leashing</b>	You were leashing
He/She/It was leashing	They were leashing

#### **Leash in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had leashed	We had leashed
You had leashed	You had leashed
He/She/It had leashed	They had leashed

### Leash in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been leashing	We had been leashing
You <b>had been leashing</b>	You had been leashing
He/She/It had been leashing	They had been leashing

## Leash in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will leash	We <b>will leash</b>
You <b>will leash</b>	You <b>will leash</b>
He/She/It will leash	They will leash

## Leash in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

SingularPluralI will be leashingWe will be leashingYou will be leashingYou will be leashingHe/She/It will be leashingThey will be leashing

#### **Leash in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have leashedWe will have leashedYou will have leashedYou will have leashedHe/She/It will have leashedThey will have leashed

#### Leash in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been leashing	We <b>will have been leashing</b>
You <b>will have been leashing</b>	You <b>will have been leashing</b>
He/She/It will have been leashing	They will have been leashing
