## Associations of "Leaves" (30 Words)

<b>algae</b>	Primitive chlorophyll-containing mainly aquatic eukaryotic organisms lacking true stems and roots and leaves.
<b><a href="#">branch</a></b>	Of a tree or plant bear or send out branches. <i>Botany is a <b>branch</b> of biology.</i>
<b>bulrush</b>	Tall marsh plant with cylindrical seed heads that explode when mature shedding large quantities of down; its long flat leaves are used for making mats and chair seats; of North America, Europe, Asia and North Africa.
<b>cabbage</b>	Any of various types of cabbage. <i>I was becoming a 27 year old <b>cabbage</b>.</i>
<b>cattail</b>	Tall erect herbs with sword-shaped leaves; cosmopolitan in fresh and salt marshes.
<b>evergreen</b>	Relating to or denoting a plant that retains green leaves throughout the year. <i><b>Evergreens</b> planted to cut off the east wind.</i>
<b>fiber</b>	Any of several elongated threadlike cells especially a muscle fiber or a nerve fiber.
<b>flower</b>	Induce a plant to produce flowers. <i>He wasted the <b>flower</b> of French youth on his dreams of empire.</i>
<b><a href="#">foliage</a></b>	The main organ of photosynthesis and transpiration in higher plants. <i>Healthy green <b>foliage</b>.</i>
<b>grass</b>	Spread out clothes on the grass to let it dry and bleach. <i>She threatened to <b>grass</b> me up.</i>
<b>green</b>	A green light. <i>You re looking <b>green</b>.</i>
<b>herb</b>	Aromatic potherb used in cookery for its savory qualities. <i>Bundles of dried <b>herbs</b>.</i>

<b>leafy</b>	Having or covered with leaves. <i>Leafy bushes.</i>
<b>lettuce</b>	Used in names of other plants with edible green leaves e g lamb s lettuce sea lettuce.
<b>moss</b>	Used in names of algae lichens and higher plants resembling moss e g reindeer moss Ceylon moss Spanish moss. <i>Nature has <b>mossed</b> the gravel walks and roads.</i>
<b>mugwort</b>	A plant of the daisy family, with aromatic divided leaves that are dark green above and whitish below, native to north temperate regions.
<b>ovule</b>	The part of the ovary of seed plants that contains the female germ cell and after fertilization becomes the seed.
<b>petiole</b>	A slender stalk between two structures, especially that between the abdomen and thorax of a wasp or ant.
<b>photosynthesis</b>	Synthesis of compounds with the aid of radiant energy (especially in plants).
<b>plant</b>	Something planted secretly for discovery by another. <i>It was raining when we <b>planted</b> him.</i>
<b>rhubarb</b>	Used in names of other plants of the same genus as rhubarb several of which are used medicinally e g Chinese rhubarb. <i>Rhubarb pie.</i>
<b>salad</b>	A vegetable suitable for eating raw. <i>A red pepper filled with tuna <b>salad</b>.</i>
<b>spinach</b>	Dark green leaves; eaten cooked or raw in salads.
<b>sprout</b>	Put forth and grow sprouts or shoots. <i>The weeds begin to <b>sprout</b>.</i>
<b>stalk</b>	A stalklike support for a sessile animal or for an organ in an animal. <i>The control <b>stalk</b> on the car s fascia.</i>
<b>tree</b>	Force a hunted animal to take refuge in a tree. <i>The hunters <b>treed</b> the bear with dogs and killed it.</i>
<b>twig</b>	Branch out in a twiglike manner. <i>Cutaneous nerve <b>twigs</b>.</i>
<b>vegetable</b>	A plant or part of a plant used as food, such as a cabbage, potato, turnip, or bean. <i>Decaying <b>vegetable</b> matter.</i>
<b>vegetative</b>	(of reproduction) characterized by asexual processes. <i>Diverse <b>vegetative</b> types.</i>
