Present Tense	<b>lech / leches</b>
Past Tense	<b>leched</b>
Present Participle	<b>leching</b>
Past Participle	<b>leched</b>

## Conjugate Lech

**Lech in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular          Plural**

I **lech**                  We **lech**  
You **lech**              You **lech**  
He/She/It **leches**    They **lech**

**Lech in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am leching**          We **are leching**  
You **are leching**      You **are leching**  
He/She/It **is leching**    They **are leching**

**Lech in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have leched**          We **have leched**  
You **have leched**      You **have leched**  
He/She/It **has leched**    They **have leched**

**Lech in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have been leching**      We **have been leching**  
You **have been leching**    You **have been leching**  
He/She/It **has been leching**    They **have been leching**

**Lech in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **leched**                  We **leched**  
You **leched**              You **leched**  
He/She/It **leched**      They **leched**

**Lech in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was leching</b>	We <b>were leching</b>
You <b>were leching</b>	You <b>were leching</b>
He/She/It <b>was leching</b>	They <b>were leching</b>

**Lech in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had leched</b>	We <b>had leched</b>
You <b>had leched</b>	You <b>had leched</b>
He/She/It <b>had leched</b>	They <b>had leched</b>

**Lech in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had been leching</b>	We <b>had been leching</b>
You <b>had been leching</b>	You <b>had been leching</b>
He/She/It <b>had been leching</b>	They <b>had been leching</b>

**Lech in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will lech</b>	We <b>will lech</b>
You <b>will lech</b>	You <b>will lech</b>
He/She/It <b>will lech</b>	They <b>will lech</b>

**Lech in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will be leching</b>	We <b>will be leching</b>
You <b>will be leching</b>	You <b>will be leching</b>
He/She/It <b>will be leching</b>	They <b>will be leching</b>

**Lech in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have leched**

**We will have leched**

**You will have leched**

**You will have leched**

**He/She/It will have leched**

**They will have leched**

**Lech in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been leching**

**We will have been leching**

**You will have been leching**

**You will have been leching**

**He/She/It will have been leching**

**They will have been leching**
