# **Conjugate Leer**

## Leer in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>leer</b>	We <b>leer</b>
You <b>leer</b>	You <b>leer</b>
He/She/It <b>leers</b>	They <b>leer</b>

## Leer in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am leering	We <b>are leering</b>
You <b>are leering</b>	You <b>are leering</b>
He/She/It is leering	They are leering

#### **Leer in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have leered	We have leered
You have leered	You have leered
He/She/It has leered	They have leered

#### Leer in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been leering	We have been leering
You have been leering	You have been leering
He/She/It has been leering	They have been leering

## Leer in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I leered	We <b>leered</b>
You <b>leered</b>	You <b>leered</b>
He/She/It <b>leered</b>	They <b>leered</b>

## Leer in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was leering	We <b>were leering</b>
You <b>were leering</b>	You <b>were leering</b>
He/She/It was leering	They were leering

#### Leer in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had leered	We had leered
You had leered	You had leered
He/She/It had leered	They had leered

## Leer in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been leering	We had been leering
You had been leering	You had been leering
He/She/It had been leering	They had been leering

## Leer in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will leer	We will leer
You <b>will leer</b>	You <b>will leer</b>
He/She/It will leer	They will leer

## Leer in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be leering	We <b>will be leering</b>
You <b>will be leering</b>	You <b>will be leering</b>
He/She/It will be leering	They will be leering

#### Leer in Future Perfect Tense



SingularPluralI will have leeredWe will have leeredYou will have leeredYou will have leeredHe/She/It will have leeredThey will have leered

#### Leer in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

SingularPluralI will have been leeringWe will have been leeringYou will have been leeringYou will have been leeringHe/She/It will have been leeringThey will have been leering
