## The Forms of Lese

Infinitive	<b>to lese</b>
Present Tense	<b>lese / leses</b>
Past Tense	<b>lesed</b>
Present Participle	<b>lesing</b>
Past Participle	<b>lesed</b>

## Conjugate Lese

### Lese in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I lese</b>	<b>We lese</b>
<b>You lese</b>	<b>You lese</b>
<b>He/She/It leses</b>	<b>They lese</b>

## **Lese in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I am lesing</b>	<b>We are lesing</b>
<b>You are lesing</b>	<b>You are lesing</b>
<b>He/She/It is lesing</b>	<b>They are lesing</b>

## **Lese in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I have lesed</b>	<b>We have lesed</b>
<b>You have lesed</b>	<b>You have lesed</b>
<b>He/She/It has lesed</b>	<b>They have lesed</b>

## **Lese in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I have been lesing</b>	<b>We have been lesing</b>
<b>You have been lesing</b>	<b>You have been lesing</b>
<b>He/She/It has been lesing</b>	<b>They have been lesing</b>

## **Lese in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>I lesed</b>	<b>We lesed</b>
<b>You lesed</b>	<b>You lesed</b>
<b>He/She/It lesed</b>	<b>They lesed</b>

## **Lese in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was lesing</b>	We <b>were lesing</b>
You <b>were lesing</b>	You <b>were lesing</b>
He/She/It <b>was lesing</b>	They <b>were lesing</b>

**Lese in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had lesed</b>	We <b>had lesed</b>
You <b>had lesed</b>	You <b>had lesed</b>
He/She/It <b>had lesed</b>	They <b>had lesed</b>

**Lese in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had been lesing</b>	We <b>had been lesing</b>
You <b>had been lesing</b>	You <b>had been lesing</b>
He/She/It <b>had been lesing</b>	They <b>had been lesing</b>

**Lese in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will lese</b>	We <b>will lese</b>
You <b>will lese</b>	You <b>will lese</b>
He/She/It <b>will lese</b>	They <b>will lese</b>

**Lese in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will be lesing</b>	We <b>will be lesing</b>
You <b>will be lesing</b>	You <b>will be lesing</b>
He/She/It <b>will be lesing</b>	They <b>will be lesing</b>

**Lese in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have lesed**

**We will have lesed**

**You will have lesed**

**You will have lesed**

**He/She/It will have lesed**

**They will have lesed**

**Lese in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been lesing**

**We will have been lesing**

**You will have been lesing**

**You will have been lesing**

**He/She/It will have been lesing**

**They will have been lesing**
