## Associations of "Level headed" (30 Words)

<b>balance</b>	A weight that balances another weight. <i>The <b>balance</b> of the voices is good.</i>
<b>climacteric</b>	Of a fruit undergoing a climacteric. <i>Most women do not experience significant psychological problems at the <b>climacteric</b>.</i>
<b>designed</b>	Done or made or performed with purpose and intent- Havelock Ellis. <i>Specially <b>designed</b> buildings.</i>
<b>dispassionate</b>	Not influenced by strong emotion, and so able to be rational and impartial. <i>A journalist should be a <b>dispassionate</b> reporter of fact.</i>
<b>equilibrium</b>	A situation in which supply and demand are matched and prices stable. <i>The <b>equilibrium</b> level of income.</i>
<b>equipoise</b>	Balance or counterbalance (something). <i>Capital flows act as an <b>equipoise</b> to international imbalances in savings.</i>
<b>even</b>	Make even or more even. <i>An <b>even</b> fight.</i>
<b>halfway</b>	At half the distance; at the middle. <i>I m incapable of doing anything even <b>halfway</b> decent.</i>
<b>homogenization</b>	The process of making things uniform or similar. <i>The <b>homogenization</b> of cream.</i>
<b>identification</b>	The act of designating or identifying something. <i>Do you have any <b>identification</b>.</i>
<b>impartial</b>	Free from undue bias or preconceived opinions. <i>The minister cannot be <b>impartial</b> in the way that a judge would be.</i>
<b>impartiality</b>	Equal treatment of all rivals or disputants; fairness. <i>Entries had to be submitted under a pseudonym to ensure <b>impartiality</b> in the judging process.</i>

<b>interim</b>	An interim dividend profit etc. <i>In the <b>interim</b> I'll just keep my fingers crossed.</i>
<b>intermediate</b>	An intermediate thing. <i>An <b>intermediate</b> range plane.</i>
<b>middlebrow</b>	A middlebrow person. <i><b>Middlebrow</b> fiction.</i>
<b>midway</b>	The place at a fair or carnival where sideshows and similar amusements are located. <i>He sensationally led the tournament at the <b>midway</b> point.</i>
<b>minded</b>	Mentally oriented toward something specified. <i>Civic <b>minded</b>.</i>
<b>neutrality</b>	The state of not supporting or helping either side in a conflict, disagreement, etc.; impartiality. <i>During the war Switzerland maintained its <b>neutrality</b>.</i>
<b>oriented</b>	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>The house had its large windows <b>oriented</b> toward the ocean view.</i>
<b>patter</b>	A quick succession of light rapid sounds. <i>He quickly <b>pattered</b> down the stairs.</i>
<b>pentavalent</b>	Having a valence of five.
<b>phase</b>	Physical chemistry a distinct state of matter in a system matter that is identical in chemical composition and physical state and separated from other material by the phase boundary. <i>The draw for the qualifying <b>phase</b> of the tournament was held over the weekend.</i>
<b>procedure</b>	A surgical operation. <i>The <b>procedure</b> is carried out under general anaesthetic.</i>
<b>progression</b>	A number of things in a series. <i>A blues <b>progression</b>.</i>
<b>proscenium</b>	The part of a modern theater stage between the curtain and the orchestra (i.e., in front of the curtain).
<b>qualification</b>	The qualification stage of a sporting event. <i>I left school at 15 with no <b>qualifications</b>.</i>
<b>step</b>	Place a ship's mast in its step. <i>She <b>stepped</b> into a life of luxury.</i>
<b>symmetry</b>	(mathematics) an attribute of a shape or relation; exact reflection of form on opposite sides of a dividing line or plane. <i>A crystal structure with hexagonal <b>symmetry</b>.</i>

Disturb the composure of.
