Conjugate Log

Log in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **log** We **log**
You **log** You **log**
He/She/It **logs** They **log**

Log in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am logging** We **are logging**
You **are logging** You **are logging**
He/She/It **is logging** They **are logging**

Log in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have logged** We **have logged**
You **have logged** You **have logged**
He/She/It **has logged** They **have logged**

Log in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been logging** We **have been logging**
You **have been logging** You **have been logging**
He/She/It **has been logging** They **have been logging**

Log in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **logged** We **logged**
You **logged** You **logged**
He/She/It **logged** They **logged**

Log in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was logging We were logging
You were logging You were logging
He/She/It was logging They were logging

Log in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had logged We had logged
You had logged You had logged
He/She/It had logged They had logged

Log in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been logging We had been logging
You had been logging You had been logging
He/She/It had been logging They had been logging

Log in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will log We will log
You will log You will log
He/She/It will log They will log

Log in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be logging We will be logging
You will be logging You will be logging
He/She/It will be logging They will be logging

Log in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have logged

We will have logged

You will have logged

You will have logged

He/She/It will have logged

They will have logged

Singular

I will have been logging

We will have been logging

You will have been logging

You will have been logging

He/She/It will have been logging

They will have been logging
