Definitions of "Loner" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “loner” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A person who avoids the company or assistance of others.*
- *A person that prefers not to associate with others.*



Synonyms of "Loner" as a noun (6 Words)

hermit

A hummingbird found in the shady lower layers of tropical forests, foraging along a regular route.

introvert

(psychology) a person who tends to shrink from social contacts and to become preoccupied with their own thoughts.

Someone who dislikes people in general.

misanthrope

*Scrooge wasn't the mean spirited **misanthrope** most of us believe him to be.*

outsider

A competitor, applicant, etc. thought to have little chance of success.
*The winner was Beech Road a fifty to one **outsider**.*

recluse

A person who lives a solitary life and tends to avoid other people.
*She has turned into a virtual **recluse**.*

solitary

One who lives in solitude.
*He had something of the **solitary** about him.*



Usage Examples of "Loner" as a noun

- *My interest in birdwatching had made me a bit of a loner.*
- *All tigers are loners, so a tigress with cubs is on her own.*
