hermit A hummingbird found in the shady lower layers of tropical forests, foraging

along a regular route.

introvert (psychology) a person who tends to shrink from social contacts and to

become preoccupied with their own thoughts.

Someone who dislikes people in general.

misanthrope Scrooge wasn t the mean spirited misanthrope most of us believe him to

be.

outsider

A competitor, applicant, etc. thought to have little chance of success.

The winner was Beech Road a fifty to one **outsider**.


recluse A person who lives a solitary life and tends to avoid other people.

She has turned into a virtual **recluse**.

Solitary
One who lives in solitude.

He had something of the **solitary** about him.
