## Associations of "Long run" (30 Words)

<a href="#">bypass</a>	An alternative channel created during a bypass operation. <i><b>Bypass</b> the farm and continue to the road.</i>
<b>circumvent</b>	Avoid or try to avoid fulfilling, answering, or performing (duties, questions, or issues). <i>It was always possible to <b>circumvent</b> the regulations.</i>
<b>dash</b>	A horizontal stroke in writing or printing to mark a pause or break in sense or to represent omitted letters or words. <i><b>Dashed</b> by the refusal.</i>
<a href="#">detour</a>	Avoid by taking a detour. <i>He <b>detoured</b> around the walls.</i>
<b>elongate</b>	Long in relation to width elongated. <i>The pup s globular body slowly <b>elongates</b>.</i>
<a href="#">elongated</a>	Drawn out or made longer spatially. <i>The old man s gaunt and <b>elongated</b> frame.</i>
<a href="#">endlessly</a>	With unflagging resolve. <i>An <b>endlessly</b> fascinating subject.</i>
<a href="#">extend</a>	Extend in scope or range or area. <i><b>Extend</b> a loan.</i>
<b>extended</b>	Fully extended or stretched forth. <i>An <b>extended</b> telescope.</i>
<b>extensible</b>	Capable of being protruded or stretched or opened out. <i>An <b>extensible</b> measuring rule.</i>
<b>furlong</b>	An eighth of a mile, 220 yards.
<b>indefinitely</b>	To an unlimited or unspecified degree or extent. <i>An <b>indefinitely</b> large number of channels.</i>

<b>jog</b>	A spell of jogging. <i>They caught and saddled their horses and <b>jogged</b> up to the high grass moorland.</i>
<b>jogger</b>	Loose trousers made of a stretchy fabric and typically elasticated at the waist and ankles, worn especially for jogging. <i>Sporty types in <b>joggers</b>.</i>
<b>lengthen</b>	Make longer. <i>In Spring the days <b>lengthen</b>.</i>
<b>lengthy</b>	(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length, especially so as to be tedious. <i><b>Lengthy</b> delays.</i>
<b>marathon</b>	A long-lasting or difficult task or activity. <i>The last leg of an interview <b>marathon</b> which began this summer.</i>
<b>outstretched</b>	(especially of a hand or arm) extended or stretched out. <i>She reached across and shook his <b>outstretched</b> hand.</i>
<u><b>postpone</b></u>	Hold back to a later time. <i>Let s <b>postpone</b> the exam.</i>
<u><b>proceed</b></u>	Continue talking. <i>From the High Street <b>proceed</b> over Magdalen Bridge.</i>
<b>prolongation</b>	Extension of the duration of something. <i>The position is advertised for two years but <b>prolongation</b> is possible.</i>
<u><b>prolonged</b></u>	Drawn out or made longer spatially. <i>A <b>prolonged</b> and bitter struggle.</i>
<b>protracted</b>	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <i><b>Protracted</b> negotiations.</i>
<b>runner</b>	A plant that spreads by means of runners. <i>The vegetable baskets were on <b>runners</b>.</i>
<b>running</b>	Executed or initiated by running. <i>In <b>running</b> or working order.</i>
<u><b>sprint</b></u>	A short, fast race in which the competitors run a distance of 400 metres or less. <i>A <b>sprint</b> planning session.</i>
<b>stretched</b>	Extended or spread over a wide area or distance. <i>Well <b>stretched</b> muscles are less susceptible to injury.</i>
<b>stroller</b>	A young urban vagrant; a street child. <i>Shady gardens where <b>strollers</b> could relax.</i>

Simulator consisting of a machine on the ground that simulates the conditions of flying a plane.

**urgently**

In a way which requires immediate action or attention.

*Housing is **urgently** needed.*
