## Associations of "Long run" (30 Words)

<u>bypass</u>	An alternative channel created during a bypass operation. <b>Bypass</b> the farm and continue to the road.
circumvent	Avoid or try to avoid fulfilling, answering, or performing (duties, questions, or issues. It was always possible to <b>circumvent</b> the regulations.
dash	A horizontal stroke in writing or printing to mark a pause or break in sense or to represent omitted letters or words. <b>Dash</b> ed by the refusal.
<u>detour</u>	Avoid by taking a detour. He <b>detour</b> ed around the walls.
elongate	Long in relation to width elongated. The pup s globular body slowly <b>elongate</b> s.
<u>elongated</u>	Drawn out or made longer spatially. The old man s gaunt and <b>elongated</b> frame.
endlessly	With unflagging resolve. An <b>endlessly</b> fascinating subject.
<u>extend</u>	Extend in scope or range or area. <i>Extend</i> a loan.
extended	Fully extended or stretched forth. An <b>extended</b> telescope.
extensible	Capable of being protruded or stretched or opened out. An <b>extensible</b> measuring rule.
furlong	An eighth of a mile, 220 yards.
indefinitely	To an unlimited or unspecified degree or extent. An <b>indefinitely</b> large number of channels.



jog	A spell of jogging. They caught and saddled their horses and <b>jog</b> ged up to the high grass moorland.
jogger	Loose trousers made of a stretchy fabric and typically elasticated at the waist and ankles, worn especially for jogging. <i>Sporty types in <b>jogger</b>s.</i>
lengthen	Make longer. In Spring the days <b>lengthen</b> .
lengthy	(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length, especially so as to be tedious. <i>Lengthy delays.</i>
marathon	A long-lasting or difficult task or activity. The last leg of an interview <b>marathon</b> which began this summer.
outstretched	(especially of a hand or arm) extended or stretched out. She reached across and shook his <b>outstretched</b> hand.
<u>postpone</u>	Hold back to a later time. Let s <b>postpone</b> the exam.
proceed	Continue talking. From the High Street <b>proceed</b> over Magdalen Bridge.
prolongation	Extension of the duration of something. The position is advertised for two years but <b>prolongation</b> is possible.
<u>prolonged</u>	Drawn out or made longer spatially. A <b>prolonged</b> and bitter struggle.
protracted	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <b>Protracted</b> negotiations.
runner	A plant that spreads by means of runners. <i>The vegetable baskets were on <b>runner</b>s.</i>
running	Executed or initiated by running. In <b>running</b> or working order.
<u>sprint</u>	A short, fast race in which the competitors run a distance of 400 metres or less. A <b>sprint</b> planning session.
stretched	Extended or spread over a wide area or distance. Well <b>stretched</b> muscles are less susceptible to injury.
stroller	A young urban vagrant; a street child. Shady gardens where <b>stroller</b> s could relax.



trainer	Simulator consisting of a machine on the ground that simulates the conditions of flying a plane. A fitness <b>trainer</b> .
urgently	In a way which requires immediate action or attention. <i>Housing is <b>urgently</b> needed.</i>
