## Associations of "Long shot meaning" (30 Words)

<a href="#">arm</a>	Used to refer to the holding of a person's arm in support or companionship. <i>They have extended the <b>arm</b> of friendship to developing countries.</i>
<b>caliber</b>	A degree or grade of excellence or worth. <i>An executive of low <b>caliber</b>.</i>
<b>catapult</b>	Move suddenly or at great speed as though hurled by a catapult. <i>The explosion <b>catapulted</b> the car 30 yards along the road.</i>
<a href="#">detour</a>	Travel via a detour. <i>He <b>detoured</b> around the walls.</i>
<b>elongate</b>	Long in relation to width elongated. <i>The pup's globular body slowly <b>elongates</b>.</i>
<a href="#">elongated</a>	Having notably more length than width; being long and slender. <i>Picasso's <b>elongated</b> Don Quixote.</i>
<a href="#">extend</a>	Thrust or extend out. <i>She <b>extended</b> her visit by another day.</i>
<b>extended</b>	Fully extended or stretched forth. <i>Surgeons with <b>extended</b> experience.</i>
<b>extensible</b>	Designed to allow the addition of new capabilities and functionality. <i>Silk is an exceptionally strong <b>extensible</b> and tough material.</i>
<b>firearm</b>	A rifle, pistol, or other portable gun. <i>Jones pleaded guilty to possessing a <b>firearm</b> with criminal intent.</i>
<b>fusillade</b>	Fire a fusillade at a place or person. <i>The Mahdi's adherents <b>fusilladed</b> his palace at Khartoum.</i>
<b>hammock</b>	A small natural hill.
<b>horizontally</b>	In a horizontal direction. <i>Labels are placed <b>horizontally</b> on the cases.</i>
<b>indefinitely</b>	For an unlimited or unspecified period of time. <i>An <b>indefinitely</b> large number of channels.</i>

<b>lengthen</b>	Become long or longer. <i>In Spring the days <b>lengthen</b>.</i>
<b>lengthy</b>	(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length, especially so as to be tedious. <i><b>Lengthy</b> delays.</i>
<b>ligament</b>	A membranous fold that supports an organ and keeps it in position.
<b>misfire</b>	A failure of a gun or missile to fire correctly. <i>As she raised her pistol again it <b>misfired</b>.</i>
<b>missive</b>	A document in the form of a letter exchanged by the parties to a contract. <i>Yet another <b>missive</b> from the Foreign Office.</i>
<b>outreach</b>	An organization's involvement with or influence in the community, especially in the context of religion or social welfare. <i><b>Outreach</b> centres.</i>
<b>outspread</b>	Fully extended or expanded. <i><b>Outspread</b> wings.</i>
<b>outstretched</b>	Fully extended especially in length. <i>A kitten with one paw <b>outstretched</b>.</i>
<b>perpetuation</b>	The continuation or preservation of a situation, idea, etc. <i><b>Perpetuation</b> of the species is our purpose.</i>
<b><u>postpone</u></b>	Cause or arrange for (something) to take place at a time later than that first scheduled. <i>The visit had to be <b>postponed</b> for some time.</i>
<b>prolongation</b>	Extension of the spatial length of something. <i>There was an indefinite <b>prolongation</b> of the peace talks.</i>
<b><u>prolonged</u></b>	Continuing for a long time or longer than usual; lengthy. <i>A <b>prolonged</b> black line across the page.</i>
<b>protracted</b>	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <i>A <b>protracted</b> and bitter dispute.</i>
<b>stretch</b>	The capacity for being stretched. <i>We lay <b>stretched</b> out on the sand.</i>
<b>stretched</b>	Relieved of stiffness by stretching. <i>Well <b>stretched</b> muscles are less susceptible to injury.</i>
<b>stretching</b>	Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.
