caliber	A degree or grade of excellence or worth. <i>An executive of low <b>caliber</b></i> .
catapult	Move suddenly or at great speed as though hurled by a catapult. The explosion <b>catapult</b> ed the car 30 yards along the road.
<u>detour</u>	Travel via a detour. He <b>detour</b> ed around the walls.
elongate	Long in relation to width elongated. The pup s globular body slowly <b>elongate</b> s.
<u>elongated</u>	Having notably more length than width; being long and slender. Picasso s <b>elongated</b> Don Quixote.
<u>extend</u>	Thrust or extend out. She <b>extend</b> ed her visit by another day.
extended	Fully extended or stretched forth. Surgeons with <b>extended</b> experience.
extensible	Designed to allow the addition of new capabilities and functionality. Silk is an exceptionally strong <b>extensible</b> and tough material.
firearm	A rifle, pistol, or other portable gun. Jones pleaded guilty to possessing a <b>firearm</b> with criminal intent.
fusillade	Fire a fusillade at a place or person. The Mahdi s adherents <b>fusillade</b> d his palace at Khartoum.
hammock	A small natural hill.
horizontally	In a horizontal direction. Labels are placed <b>horizontally</b> on the cases.
indefinitely	For an unlimited or unspecified period of time. An <b>indefinitely</b> large number of channels.



lengthen	Become long or longer. In Spring the days <b>lengthen</b> .
lengthy	(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length, especially so as to be tedious. <i>Lengthy delays</i> .
ligament	A membranous fold that supports an organ and keeps it in position.
misfire	A failure of a gun or missile to fire correctly. As she raised her pistol again it <b>misfire</b> d.
missive	A document in the form of a letter exchanged by the parties to a contract. Yet another <b>missive</b> from the Foreign Office.
outreach	An organization's involvement with or influence in the community, especially in the context of religion or social welfare. <i>Outreach</i> centres.
outspread	Fully extended or expanded. <i>Outspread</i> wings.
outstretched	Fully extended especially in length. A kitten with one paw <b>outstretched</b> .
perpetuation	The continuation or preservation of a situation, idea, etc. <b>Perpetuation</b> of the species is our purpose.
<u>postpone</u>	Cause or arrange for (something) to take place at a time later than that first scheduled. The visit had to be <b>postpone</b> d for some time.
prolongation	Extension of the spatial length of something. There was an indefinite <b>prolongation</b> of the peace talks.
<u>prolonged</u>	Continuing for a long time or longer than usual; lengthy. A <b>prolonged</b> black line across the page.
protracted	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. A <b>protracted</b> and bitter dispute.
stretch	The capacity for being stretched. We lay <b>stretch</b> ed out on the sand.
stretched	Relieved of stiffness by stretching. Well <b>stretched</b> muscles are less susceptible to injury.
stretching	Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.
