fusillade Fire a fusillade at a place or person.

The Mahdi s adherents **fusillade**d his palace at Khartoum.

hammock A small natural hill.

horizontally In a horizontal direction.

Labels are placed **horizontally** on the cases.

indefinitely For an unlimited or unspecified period of time.

An **indefinitely** large number of channels.



lengthen Become long or longer.

In Spring the days lengthen.

(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length,

lengthy especially so as to be tedious.

Lengthy delays.

ligament A membranous fold that supports an organ and keeps it in position.

misfireA failure of a gun or missile to fire correctly.
As she raised her pistol again it **misfire**d.

missiveA document in the form of a letter exchanged by the parties to a contract.

Yet another **missive** from the Foreign Office.

An organization's involvement with or influence in the community,

outreach especially in the context of religion or social welfare.

Outreach centres.

outspread Fully extended or expanded.

Outspread wings.

outstretched Fully extended especially in length.

A kitten with one paw **outstretched**.

The continuation or preservation of a situation, idea, etc.

Perpetuation of the species is our purpose.

Cause or arrange for (something) to take place at a time later than that first

postpone scheduled.

The visit had to be **postpone**d for some time.

prolongation Extension of the spatial length of something.

There was an indefinite **prolongation** of the peace talks.

prolongedContinuing for a long time or longer than usual; lengthy.

A **prolonged** black line across the page.

protracted Relatively long in duration tediously protracted.

A **protracted** and bitter dispute.

stretch The capacity for being stretched.

We lay **stretch**ed out on the sand.

stretched Relieved of stiffness by stretching.

Well **stretched** muscles are less susceptible to injury.

stretching Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.
