Associations of "Long shot meaning" (30 Words)

arm	Used to refer to the holding of a person's arm in support or companionship. <i>They have extended the arm of friendship to developing countries.</i>
caliber	A degree or grade of excellence or worth. <i>An executive of low caliber.</i>
catapult	Move suddenly or at great speed as though hurled by a catapult. <i>The explosion catapulted the car 30 yards along the road.</i>
detour	Travel via a detour. <i>He detoured around the walls.</i>
elongate	Long in relation to width elongated. <i>The pup's globular body slowly elongates.</i>
elongated	Having notably more length than width; being long and slender. <i>Picasso's elongated Don Quixote.</i>
extend	Thrust or extend out. <i>She extended her visit by another day.</i>
extended	Fully extended or stretched forth. <i>Surgeons with extended experience.</i>
extensible	Designed to allow the addition of new capabilities and functionality. <i>Silk is an exceptionally strong extensible and tough material.</i>
firearm	A rifle, pistol, or other portable gun. <i>Jones pleaded guilty to possessing a firearm with criminal intent.</i>
fusillade	Fire a fusillade at a place or person. <i>The Mahdi's adherents fusilladed his palace at Khartoum.</i>
hammock	A small natural hill.
horizontally	In a horizontal direction. <i>Labels are placed horizontally on the cases.</i>
indefinitely	For an unlimited or unspecified period of time. <i>An indefinitely large number of channels.</i>

lengthen	Become long or longer. <i>In Spring the days lengthen.</i>
lengthy	(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length, especially so as to be tedious. <i>Lengthy delays.</i>
ligament	A membranous fold that supports an organ and keeps it in position.
misfire	A failure of a gun or missile to fire correctly. <i>As she raised her pistol again it misfired.</i>
missive	A document in the form of a letter exchanged by the parties to a contract. <i>Yet another missive from the Foreign Office.</i>
outreach	An organization's involvement with or influence in the community, especially in the context of religion or social welfare. <i>Outreach centres.</i>
outspread	Fully extended or expanded. <i>Outspread wings.</i>
outstretched	Fully extended especially in length. <i>A kitten with one paw outstretched.</i>
perpetuation	The continuation or preservation of a situation, idea, etc. <i>Perpetuation of the species is our purpose.</i>
<u>postpone</u>	Cause or arrange for (something) to take place at a time later than that first scheduled. <i>The visit had to be postponed for some time.</i>
prolongation	Extension of the spatial length of something. <i>There was an indefinite prolongation of the peace talks.</i>
<u>prolonged</u>	Continuing for a long time or longer than usual; lengthy. <i>A prolonged black line across the page.</i>
protracted	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <i>A protracted and bitter dispute.</i>
stretch	The capacity for being stretched. <i>We lay stretched out on the sand.</i>
stretched	Relieved of stiffness by stretching. <i>Well stretched muscles are less susceptible to injury.</i>
stretching	Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.
