## Associations of "Long standing" (30 Words)

confirmed	(of a person) firmly established in a particular habit, belief, or way of life and unlikely to change their ways. <i>A confirmed</i> bachelor.
continued	Without stop or interruption. The <b>continued</b> popularity of Westerns.
continuously	Repeatedly without exceptions or reversals. <i>These images loop <b>continuously</b></i> .
elongate	Long in relation to width elongated. The old man s gaunt and <b>elongate</b> d frame.
<u>elongated</u>	Drawn out or made longer spatially. An alien being with an <b>elongated</b> head.
endless	Having no known beginning and presumably no end. <i>Time is <b>endless</b>.</i>
<u>enduring</u>	Patiently bearing continual wrongs or trouble. An <b>enduring</b> disposition.
<u>ever</u>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. They lived happily <b>ever</b> after.
<u>extend</u>	Extend in scope or range or area. <i>Extend</i> the loan.
extended	Fully extended or stretched forth. An <b>extended</b> discussion.
<u>forever</u>	Without interruption. She took <b>forever</b> to write the paper.
incessantly	Without interruption; constantly. She talked about him <b>incessantly</b> .
indefinitely	For an unlimited or unspecified period of time. <i>Talks cannot go on <b>indefinitely</b>.</i>



interminable	Endless or apparently endless (often used hyperbolically. We got bogged down in <b>interminable</b> discussions.
lank	Of a person lanky. The man had <b>lank</b> brown greasy hair.
lasting	Lasting a long time without change. A long <b>lasting</b> friendship.
<u>length</u>	The length of a horse boat etc as a measure of the lead in a race. A <b>length</b> of brown satin.
lengthen	Make or become longer. The mascara will <b>lengthen</b> your lashes.
lengthy	Relatively long in duration; tediously protracted. A <b>lengthy</b> visit from her mother in law.
longitudinal	Relating to longitude; measured from east to west. <i>Longitudinal</i> muscles.
perpetual	(of an investment) having no fixed maturity date; irredeemable. A <b>perpetual</b> secretary of the society.
perpetuation	The continuation or preservation of a situation, idea, etc. We criticized the <b>perpetuation</b> of racial stereotypes.
<u>postpone</u>	Cause or arrange for (something) to take place at a time later than that first scheduled. The visit had to be <b>postpone</b> d for some time.
prolongation	The consequence of being lengthened in duration. The position is advertised for two years but <b>prolongation</b> is possible.
protracted	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <b>Protracted</b> negotiations.
spindly	Long and lean. <i>Spindly</i> chairs.
stretched	Relieved of stiffness by stretching. Broad fields lay <b>stretched</b> on both sides of us.
unceasingly	With unflagging resolve.
unlimited	Without reservation or exception. Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not <b>unlimited</b> .
