## Associations of "Longed" (30 Words)

<b>continued</b>	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. <i>He asked for their <b>continued</b> support.</i>
<b>continuously</b>	With unflagging resolve. <i>These images loop <b>continuously</b>.</i>
<b><u>detour</u></b>	Avoid by taking a detour. <i>He <b>detoured</b> around the walls.</i>
<b>elongate</b>	Long in relation to width elongated. <i>The old man s gaunt and <b>elongated</b> frame.</i>
<b><u>elongated</u></b>	Having notably more length than width; being long and slender. <i>The old man s gaunt and <b>elongated</b> frame.</i>
<b>endless</b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>An <b>endless</b> conversation.</i>
<b><u>endlessly</u></b>	With unflagging resolve. <i>The original episodes were <b>endlessly</b> repeated.</i>
<b><u>enduring</u></b>	Unceasing. <i>He formed a number of <b>enduring</b> relationships with women.</i>
<b><u>ever</u></b>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>Having to borrow <b>ever</b> larger sums.</i>
<b><u>extend</u></b>	Extend in scope or range or area. <i>My land <b>extends</b> over the hills on the horizon.</i>
<b>extended</b>	Fully extended or stretched forth. <i>The <b>extended</b> airport runways can accommodate larger planes.</i>
<b>extensible</b>	Designed to allow the addition of new capabilities and functionality. <i>An <b>extensible</b> architecture designed to accommodate changes.</i>
<b><u>forever</u></b>	For all future time; for always. <i>We had to wait <b>forever</b> and a day.</i>

<b>incessantly</b>	With unflagging resolve. <i>She talked about him <b>incessantly</b>.</i>
<b>indefinitely</b>	To an unlimited or unspecified degree or extent. <i>Talks cannot go on <b>indefinitely</b>.</i>
<b>infinitely</b>	To a very great degree; immensely. <i>There are issues here that could be expanded <b>infinitely</b>.</i>
<b>interminable</b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>We got bogged down in <b>interminable</b> discussions.</i>
<b>length</b>	The length of a horse boat etc as a measure of the lead in a race. <i>The <b>length</b> of the syllable is isomorphic with the <b>length</b> of the syllabic vowel.</i>
<b>lengthen</b>	Make or become longer. <i>In the spring when the days are <b>lengthening</b>.</i>
<b>lengthy</b>	Relatively long in duration; tediously protracted. <i><b>Lengthy</b> delays.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	(of an investment) having no fixed maturity date; irredeemable. <i>Deep caves in <b>perpetual</b> darkness.</i>
<b>perpetuation</b>	The act of prolonging something. <i>We criticized the <b>perpetuation</b> of racial stereotypes.</i>
<b>postpone</b>	Hold back to a later time. <i>The visit had to be <b>postponed</b> for some time.</i>
<b>prolongation</b>	Amount or degree or range to which something extends. <i>An agreement on further <b>prolongation</b> of the boundary proved difficult.</i>
<b>prolonged</b>	Continuing for a long time or longer than usual; lengthy. <i>The region suffered a <b>prolonged</b> drought.</i>
<b>protracted</b>	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <i><b>Protracted</b> negotiations.</i>
<b>stretch</b>	Make long or longer by pulling and stretching. <i>There were <b>stretches</b> of boredom.</i>
<b>stretched</b>	(of muscles) relieved of stiffness by stretching. <i>Well <b>stretched</b> muscles are less susceptible to injury.</i>
<b>stretching</b>	Exercise designed to extend the limbs and muscles to their full extent.
<b>unceasingly</b>	With unflagging resolve.
