| akin | Of similar character. <i>A feeling akin to terror.</i> |
| alike | (of two or more people or things) similar to each other. <i>They dressed alike in black trousers and jackets.</i> |
| appearance | Formal attendance (in court or at a hearing) of a party in an action. <i>The appearance of the railway.</i> |
| askance | With suspicion or disapproval. <i>The reformers looked askance at the mystical tradition.</i> |
| browse | Shop around; not necessarily buying. <i>A moose needs to eat forty to fifty pounds of browse a day.</i> |
| comparable | Conforming in every respect. <i>Nobody is comparable with this athlete.</i> |
| conformable | Disposed or willing to comply. <i>Plans conformable with your wishes.</i> |
| contented | Feeling or expressing happiness or satisfaction. <i>A contented smile.</i> |
| disapproving | Expressing or manifesting disapproval. <i>He shot a disapproving glance at her.</i> |
| funny | A joke or witty remark. <i>They have some funny ideas about war.</i> |
| gaze | Look steadily and intently, especially in admiration, surprise, or thought. <i>The male gaze.</i> |
| glance | Throw a glance at take a brief look at. <i>Sunlight glanced off the curved body of a dolphin.</i> |
| identify | Give the name or identifying characteristics of refer to by name or some other identifying characteristic property. <i>3.2% of the men identified as gay or bisexual.</i> |

| likeness | Similarity in appearance or character or nature between persons or things. <i>Man created God in his own likeness.</i> |
| peek | Throw a glance at; take a brief look at. <i>His socks were so full of holes his toes peeked through.</i> |
| pro | A prostitute. <i>A pro golfer.</i> |
| quasi | Having some resemblance. <i>A quasi success.</i> |
| resemblance | A way in which two or more things are alike. <i>The physical resemblances between humans and apes.</i> |
| rummage | A jumble of things to be given away. <i>Mick rummaged up his skateboard.</i> |
| searching | Exploring thoroughly. <i>A searching investigation of their past dealings.</i> |
| semblance | Resemblance similarity. <i>She tried to force her thoughts back into some semblance of order.</i> |
| sidelong | (used especially of glances) directed to one side with or as if with doubt or suspicion or envy. <i>Shot out sidelong boughs.</i> |
| sideways | By an indirect way. <i>He hurried towards his office without a sideways glance.</i> |
| similarity | The quality of being similar. <i>The similarity of symptoms makes them hard to diagnose.</i> |
| similitude | The quality or state of being similar to something. <i>Conrad uses a range of constructions which express or imply similitude.</i> |
| smug | Having or showing an excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements. <i>He was feeling smug after his win.</i> |
| squint | Be cross eyed have a squint or strabismus. <i>I had a bad squint.</i> |
| stare | (of a person's eyes) be wide open, with a fixed or vacant expression. <i>The obituaries stared out at us.</i> |
| staring | Open and fixed as if in fear or wonder. <i>Staring eyes.</i> |
| upside | The more positive aspect of a situation. <i>Being self employed has its upside.</i> |
