### **Definitions of "Loophole" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “loophole” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *An arrow slit in a wall.*
- *An ambiguity or inadequacy in the law or a set of rules.*
- *A small hole in a fortified wall; for observation or discharging weapons.*
- *An ambiguity (especially one in the text of a law or contract) that makes it possible to evade a difficulty or obligation.*



## Synonyms of "Loophole" as a noun (12 Words)

<b>aperture</b>	An man-made opening; usually small. <i>A refracting telescope with an <b>aperture</b> of 3 inches.</i>
<b>escape clause</b>	The act of escaping physically.
<b>escape route</b>	An avoidance of danger or difficulty.
<b>gap</b>	A pass or way through a range of hills. <i>He peeped through the <b>gap</b> in the curtains.</i>
<b>hole</b>	An awkward situation. <i>Stephen lost the first three <b>holes</b> to Eric.</i>
<b>means of avoidance</b>	How a result is obtained or an end is achieved.
<b>means of escape</b>	Considerable capital (wealth or income).
<b>means of evasion</b>	How a result is obtained or an end is achieved.
<b>opening</b>	The act of opening something. <i>They seem to have exploited fully the <b>openings</b> offered.</i>

**slit**

A long narrow opening.  
Arrow **slits**.

**slot**

A slot machine that is used for gambling.  
He slid a coin into the **slot** of the jukebox.



## Usage Examples of "Loophole" as a noun
