# **Conjugate Loricate**

## Loricate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>loricate</b>	We <b>loricate</b>
You <b>loricate</b>	You <b>loricate</b>
He/She/It loricates	They loricate

## Loricate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am loricating	We <b>are loricating</b>
You <b>are loricating</b>	You <b>are loricating</b>
He/She/It is loricating	They are loricating

#### **Loricate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have loricated	We have loricated
You have loricated	You have loricated
He/She/It has loricated	They have loricated

## **Loricate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been loricating	We have been loricating
You have been loricating	You have been loricating
He/She/It has been loricating	They have been loricating

## Loricate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I loricated	We loricated
You <b>loricated</b>	You <b>loricated</b>
He/She/It loricated	They <b>loricated</b>

## Loricate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



SingularPluralI was loricatingWe were loricatingYou were loricatingYou were loricatingHe/She/It was loricatingThey were loricating

### **Loricate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had loricated	We had loricated
You <b>had loricated</b>	You had loricated
He/She/It had loricated	They had loricated

## **Loricate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been loricating	We had been loricating
You <b>had been loricating</b>	You had been loricating
He/She/It had been loricating	They had been loricating

## Loricate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will loricate	We <b>will loricate</b>
You <b>will loricate</b>	You <b>will loricate</b>
He/She/It will loricate	They will loricate

## Loricate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be loricating	We will be loricating
You <b>will be loricating</b>	You will be loricating
He/She/It will be loricating	They will be loricating
