Definitions of "Lounge" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “loungue” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *An upholstered seat for more than one person.*
- *A sitting room in a house.*
- *A public room in a hotel, theatre, or club in which to sit and relax.*
- *An act or spell of lounging.*
- *A room (as in a hotel or airport) with seating where people can wait.*
- *A seating area in an airport for waiting passengers.*



Synonyms of "Lounge" as a noun (15 Words)

- common room** A piece of open land for recreational use in an urban area.
- couch** A reclining seat with a headrest at one end on which a psychoanalyst's subject or doctor's patient lies while undergoing treatment.
*The child was lying on the examination **couch**.*
- drawing room** Act of getting or draining something such as electricity or a liquid from a source.
- family room** A loose affiliation of gangsters in charge of organized criminal activities.
- front room** The immediate proximity of someone or something.
- living room** The condition of living or the state of being alive.
- morning room** The first light of day.
- parlour** A room in a public building for receiving guests.
*The mayor's **parlour**.*
- public room** A body of people sharing some common interest.

reception room	The manner in which something is greeted.
salon	Gallery where works of art can be displayed. <i>Washington political salons.</i>
sitting room	The act of assuming a certain position (as for a photograph or portrait).
<u>sofa</u>	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <i>Sofa cushions.</i>
waiting area	The act of waiting (remaining inactive in one place while expecting something).
waiting room	The act of waiting (remaining inactive in one place while expecting something).

- *Sit or recline comfortably.*
- *Be about.*
- *Lie, sit, or stand in a relaxed or lazy way.*



Synonyms of "Lounge" as a verb (27 Words)

drape oneself	Place casually.
footle	Be about. <i>Where's that pesky creature that was footling about outside?</i>
hang around	Hold on tightly or tenaciously.
lallygag	Be about.
laze	Pass time in a relaxed, lazy way. Laze away a long summer day.
lean back	Cause to lean to the side.
lie	Originate (in). <i>His epitaph reads Here lies Garcia King of Galicia and Portugal.</i>
lie back	Have a place in relation to something else.

linger	Be slow to disappear or die. <i>The shy student lingered in the corner.</i>
loaf	Be about.
loiter	Be about. <i>The high school students like to loiter in the Central Square.</i>
loll	(of a part of the body) hang loosely; droop. <i>The boy lolled out his tongue.</i>
lollygag	Dawdle. <i>We re lollygagging along.</i>
lurk	Be about. <i>A ruthless killer still lurked in the darkness.</i>
luxuriate	Become extravagant; indulge (oneself) luxuriously. <i>She was luxuriating in a long bath.</i>
mess about	Eat in a mess hall.
mill about	Produce a ridge around the edge of.
mill around	Grind with a mill.
put one's feet up	Cause to be in a certain state; cause to be in a certain relation.
recline	Cause to recline. <i>He tried to recline his seat.</i>
relax	Cause to feel relaxed. <i>The team relax with a lot of skiing.</i>
repose	Lean in a comfortable resting position. <i>I ll go to him and repose our distresses on his friendly bosom.</i>
rest	Rest on or as if on a pillow. <i>The country s security rested on its alliances.</i>
stretch oneself	Lie down comfortably.
take it easy	Get into one's hands, take physically.
tarry	Leave slowly and hesitantly.
unwind	Become less tense, rest, or take one's ease. <i>The Grand Hotel is a superb place to unwind.</i>

airy

Delicate, as though filled with or made of air.
*Her **airy** presence filled the house.*

ample

Enough or more than enough; plentiful.
*He leaned back in his **ample** chair.*

armchair

A large, comfortable chair with side supports for a person's arms.
*An **armchair** traveller.*

bed

Used with reference to a bed as the typical place for sexual activity.
*A three **bed** detached house.*

bookcase

A piece of furniture with shelves for storing books.

broad

Broad in scope or content.
*Generous and **broad** sympathies.*

cafeteria	Denoting a system in which people may choose from a number of available options, especially one in which an employee may select a personal package of company benefits. <i>Employers who offer cafeteria plans and other flexible programs.</i>
capacious	Large in capacity. <i>She rummaged in her capacious handbag.</i>
<u>chair</u>	The person in charge of a meeting or of an organization used as a neutral alternative to chairman or chairwoman. <i>He was due to step down after a three year stint in the chair.</i>
commodious	Roomy and comfortable. <i>A commodious building suitable for conventions.</i>
corridor	A long passage in a building from which doors lead into rooms. <i>The security forces established corridors for humanitarian supplies.</i>
<u>couch</u>	Treat (a cataract) by pushing the lens of the eye downwards and backwards, out of line with the pupil. <i>The child was lying on the examination couch.</i>
cupboard	A recess or piece of furniture with a door and typically shelves, used for storage. <i>A broom cupboard.</i>
<u>cushion</u>	A mechanical damper; absorbs energy of sudden impulses. <i>To cushion the blow wages and pensions were increased.</i>
extensive	Large in spatial extent or range or scope or quantity. <i>An extensive collection of silver.</i>
fridge	A refrigerator. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the fridge.</i>
furnishing	Denoting fabrics used for curtains or upholstery. <i>The furnishing comprised three easy chairs and one oval table.</i>
panoramic	(of a view or picture) with a wide view surrounding the observer; sweeping. <i>On a clear day there are panoramic views.</i>
pillow	Rest one's head as if on a pillow. <i>Pillow your head.</i>
plank	Cover with planks. <i>He planked the money on the table.</i>
recliner	A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest.
roomy	Having ample space. <i>Roomy trousers.</i>

seat	Provide with seats. <i>Owen seated his guests in the draughty baronial hall.</i>
<u>sofa</u>	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <i>Sofa cushions.</i>
<u>spacious</u>	(especially of a room or building) having ample space. <i>A spacious ballroom.</i>
stool	Lure with a stool as of wild fowl. <i>Fibre in the child s diet will soften the stools.</i>
<u>sweeping</u>	Dirt or refuse collected by sweeping. <i>A sweeping assertion.</i>
vast	An immense space. <i>The vast accumulation of knowledge which we call civilization.</i>
wholesale	At a wholesale price. <i>The wholesale destruction of these animals by poachers.</i>
<u>wide</u>	A ball that is judged to be too wide of the stumps for the batsman to play for which an extra is awarded to the batting side. <i>The arrow was wide of the mark.</i>
