- *A partner in a sexual or romantic relationship outside marriage.*
- *A significant other to whom you are not related by marriage.*
- *A person who loves someone or is loved by someone.*
- *A person who likes or enjoys a specified thing.*
- *An ardent follower and admirer.*



Synonyms of "Lover" as a noun (22 Words)

- addict** A person who is addicted to a particular substance typically an illegal drug.
*A golf **addict**.*
- admirer** A person who backs a politician or a team etc.
*He was a great **admirer** of Henry James.*
- aficionado** A person who is very knowledgeable and enthusiastic about an activity, subject, or pastime.
*A crossword **aficionado**.*
- beloved** A beloved person used as terms of endearment.
*He watched his **beloved** from afar.*
- boyfriend** A person's regular male companion with whom they have a romantic or sexual relationship.
*A **boyfriend** cardigan.*
- buff** A soft thick undyed leather from the skins of e g buffalo or oxen.
*A **buff** envelope.*

<u>darling</u>	A lovable or endearing person. <i>He is such a darling.</i>
devotee	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. <i>Devotees of Krishna.</i>
enthusiast	An ardent and enthusiastic supporter of some person or activity. <i>A sports car enthusiast.</i>
<u>fan</u>	A fan shaped alluvial or talus deposit at the foot of a slope. <i>There are great waste fans at the foot of the Andes in the desert.</i>
fanatic	A person motivated by irrational enthusiasm (as for a cause). <i>A fanatic is one who can't change his mind and won't change the subject.</i>
follower	Someone who is tracking a particular person, group, organization, etc. on a social media website or application. <i>He is a keen follower of football.</i>
<u>girlfriend</u>	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>He lives with his girlfriend.</i>
hound	Used in names of dogfishes e.g. nurse hound, smooth hound. <i>He has a reputation as a publicity hound.</i>
lady friend	A woman of the peerage in Britain.
love	A person or thing that one loves. <i>They were both in love with her.</i>
loved one	A deep feeling of sexual desire and attraction.
man	An adult male person who has a manly character, virile and courageous competent. <i>He awaited word from his man in Havana.</i>
<u>partner</u>	A person who is a member of a partnership. <i>He began to call potential coalition partners about forming a new government.</i>
supporter	A band (usually elastic) worn around the leg to hold up a stocking (or around the arm to hold up a sleeve). <i>All their supporters came out for the game.</i>
<u>sweetheart</u>	Any well-liked individual. <i>The pair were childhood sweethearts.</i>
woman	A disrespectful form of address to a woman. <i>A daily woman.</i>



Usage Examples of "Lover" as a noun

- *They had been lovers for years.*
- *I think she had a secret lover.*
- *He was a great lover of cats.*
- *Music lovers.*

- admiration** A favorable judgment.
*A small token in **admiration** of your works.*
- admirer** A person who has a particular regard for someone or something.
*He was a great **admirer** of Henry James.*
- ardent** Characterized by intense emotion.
***Ardent** love.*
- beau** A rich, fashionable young man; a dandy.
- boyfriend** A man who is the lover of a man or woman.
*If I d known he was her **boyfriend** I wouldn t have asked.*
- buff** Of the yellowish beige color of buff leather.
*Swimming in the **buff** means to swim naked.*
- concubine** A woman who cohabits with an important man.

devotee	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. <i>Devotees of Krishna.</i>
ex	The 24th letter of the Roman alphabet. <i>All his exes live in Texas.</i>
fan	A thing resembling an open fan. <i>His breath fanned her skin as he leant towards her.</i>
fiance	A man who is engaged to be married.
fiancee	A woman who is engaged to be married.
girlfriend	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>She would rather go to the cinema with a girlfriend.</i>
guy	Steady or support with a guy wire or cable. <i>She never stopped guying him about his weight.</i>
husband	A married man considered in relation to his spouse. <i>She husbanded their financial resources through difficult times.</i>
icon	A sign which has a characteristic in common with the thing it signifies, for example the word snarl pronounced in a snarling way. <i>This iron jawed icon of American manhood.</i>
idolater	A person who worships idols.
idolatry	The worship of idols. <i>We must not allow our idolatry of art to obscure issues of political significance.</i>
love	A beloved person used as terms of endearment. <i>She loves her boss and works hard for him.</i>
mistress	(especially formerly) a female employer of domestic staff. <i>She is always mistress of the situation coolly self possessed.</i>
moll	The girlfriend of a gangster. <i>I'd rush the money over to his moll.</i>
monotheism	The doctrine or belief that there is only one God.
pagan	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A pagan god.</i>
paramour	A woman's lover.
spouse	A person's partner in marriage.
veneration	A feeling of profound respect for someone or something. <i>His respect for the law bordered on veneration.</i>
votary	A priest or priestess (or consecrated worshipper) in a non-Christian religion or cult. <i>He was a votary of John Keats.</i>

Take in marriage.

*In this album he **weds** an excellent programme with a distinctive vocal style.*

wife

The wife of a person with a specified occupation.

*A clergy **wife**.*

worship

The activity of worshipping.

*She adores her sons and they **worship** her.*
