

Definitions of "Lovers" as a noun

- *A significant other to whom you are not related by marriage.*



Synonyms of "Lovers" as a noun (3 Words)

buff

A soft thick undyed leather from the skins of e g buffalo or oxen.
*Swimming in the **buff** means to swim naked.*

devotee

A person who is very interested in and enthusiastic about someone or something.
***Devotees** of Krishna.*

fan

A fan shaped alluvial or talus deposit at the foot of a slope.
***Fan** vaulting.*



Associations of "Lovers" (30 Words)

<u>admiration</u>	A feeling of delighted approval and liking. <i>A small token in admiration of your works.</i>
<u>admirer</u>	Someone who admires a young woman. <i>She had many admirers.</i>
<u>ardent</u>	Burning; glowing. <i>Ardent revolutionaries.</i>
beau	A man who is the lover of a girl or young woman.
<u>boyfriend</u>	Denoting an item of clothing for a woman or girl that is designed to be loose-fitting or slightly oversized. <i>When the law changed Pet could finally married his long time boyfriend Jim.</i>
<u>buff</u>	Of the yellowish beige color of buff leather. <i>The wind buffeted him.</i>
<u>concubine</u>	A woman who cohabits with an important man.
devotee	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. <i>A devotee of Lewis Carroll.</i>
ex	Out of fashion. <i>All his exes live in Texas.</i>
<u>fan</u>	A fan shaped alluvial or talus deposit at the foot of a slope. <i>Fan vaulting.</i>
fiance	A man who is engaged to be married.
fiancee	A woman who is engaged to be married.
<u>girlfriend</u>	A woman's female friend. <i>He lives with his girlfriend.</i>
<u>guy</u>	Steady or support with a guy wire or cable. <i>The Italians guyed the Tower of Pisa to prevent it from collapsing.</i>
<u>husband</u>	Use (resources) economically. <i>She husbanded their financial resources through difficult times.</i>
<u>icon</u>	A sign which has a characteristic in common with the thing it signifies, for example the word snarl pronounced in a snarling way. <i>This iron jawed icon of American manhood.</i>
idolater	A person who worships idols.
idolatry	Religious zeal; the willingness to serve God. <i>We must not allow our idolatry of art to obscure issues of political significance.</i>

love	A beloved person used as terms of endearment. <i>His love for football.</i>
mistress	The female owner of a dog, cat, or other domesticated animal. <i>She is always mistress of the situation coolly self possessed.</i>
moll	The girlfriend of a gangster. <i>I d rush the money over to his moll.</i>
monotheism	Belief in a single God.
pagan	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A Muslim majority had to live in close proximity to large communities of Christians and pagans.</i>
<u>paramour</u>	A lover, especially the illicit partner of a married person.
<u>spouse</u>	A person's partner in marriage.
veneration	Religious zeal; the willingness to serve God. <i>The traditional veneration of saints.</i>
votary	A devoted follower, adherent, or advocate of someone or something. <i>He was a votary of John Keats.</i>
wed	Be obstinately attached or devoted to (an activity, belief, or system). <i>They wed a week after meeting.</i>
<u>wife</u>	The wife of a person with a specified occupation. <i>He and his wife are keen gardeners.</i>
<u>worship</u>	The activity of worshipping. <i>Worship of the Mother Goddess.</i>
