descent	A downward slope or bend. <i>His descents on the manager of any shop he took a fancy to visit.</i>
down	Cause to come or go down. <i>The down escalator.</i>

downcast	A ventilation shaft through which air enters a mine. A downcast glance.
downward	On or toward a surface regarded as a base. The downward course of the stream.
droop	An act or instance of drooping a limp or weary attitude. The exhausted droop of her shoulders.
essential	A thing that is absolutely necessary. The essentials of the good life.
falling	Decreasing in amount or degree. Falling temperatures.
grim	Harshly uninviting or formidable in manner or appearance. Few creatures thrive in this grim and hostile land.
improbably	Not easy to believe. Everyone in the film is improbably gorgeous.
incredibly	To a great degree; extremely. Incredibly he was still alive.
integral	The result of a mathematical integration $F(x)$ is the integral of $f(x)$ if $dF/dx = f(x)$. Systematic training should be integral to library management.
located	Situated in a particular spot or position. Valuable centrally located urban land.
necessary	The action or item needed. A bag containing my wallet the money the necessary .
nether	Located below or beneath something else. Gnawed his nether lip.
originally	In a novel and inventive way. The suggestions so originally and persuasively outlined.
profundity	Great depth or intensity of a state, quality, or emotion. The profundity of the mine was almost a mile.
under	Under water. The under parts of a machine.
underside	The less favourable aspect of something. The sordid underside of the glamorous 1980s.
vital	Full of spirit; full of life. Secrecy is of vital importance.
