<b>constitutive</b>	Forming an essential element of something. <i>The state began to exercise a new and <b>constitutive</b> function.</i>
<b>deeply</b>	To a great depth; far down or in. <i>He breathed <b>deeply</b>.</i>
<b>depressed</b>	(of a person) suffering from clinical depression. <i>The market is <b>depressed</b>.</i>
<b>descending</b>	(of sound) becoming lower in pitch. <i>A rocky <b>descending</b> path.</i>
<a href="#">descent</a>	A downward slope or bend. <i>His <b>descents</b> on the manager of any shop he took a fancy to visit.</i>
<a href="#">down</a>	Cause to come or go down. <i>The <b>down</b> escalator.</i>

<b>downcast</b>	A ventilation shaft through which air enters a mine. A <b>downcast</b> glance.
<b>downward</b>	On or toward a surface regarded as a base. The <b>downward</b> course of the stream.
<b>droop</b>	An act or instance of drooping a limp or weary attitude. The exhausted <b>droop</b> of her shoulders.
<b>essential</b>	A thing that is absolutely necessary. The <b>essentials</b> of the good life.
<b>falling</b>	Decreasing in amount or degree. <b>Falling</b> temperatures.
<b>grim</b>	Harshly uninviting or formidable in manner or appearance. Few creatures thrive in this <b>grim</b> and hostile land.
<b>improbably</b>	Not easy to believe. Everyone in the film is <b>improbably</b> gorgeous.
<b>incredibly</b>	To a great degree; extremely. <b>Incredibly</b> he was still alive.
<b>integral</b>	The result of a mathematical integration $F(x)$ is the integral of $f(x)$ if $dF/dx = f(x)$ . Systematic training should be <b>integral</b> to library management.
<b>located</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. Valuable centrally <b>located</b> urban land.
<b>necessary</b>	The action or item needed. A bag containing my wallet the money the <b>necessary</b> .
<b>nether</b>	Located below or beneath something else. Gnawed his <b>nether</b> lip.
<b>originally</b>	In a novel and inventive way. The suggestions so <b>originally</b> and persuasively outlined.
<b>profundity</b>	Great depth or intensity of a state, quality, or emotion. The <b>profundity</b> of the mine was almost a mile.
<b>under</b>	Under water. The <b>under</b> parts of a machine.
<b>underside</b>	The less favourable aspect of something. The sordid <b>underside</b> of the glamorous 1980s.
<b>vital</b>	Full of spirit; full of life. Secrecy is of <b>vital</b> importance.
